GOVERNOR WILLIAM LANGER
BISMARCK, NORTH DAKOTA

IT HAS BEEN DEFINITELY SHOWN THAT A LARGER PORTION OF FEDERAL MONEY SPENT ON PUBLIC ROADS GOES TO LABOR THAN GOES TO LABOR IN ANY OTHER CONSTRUCTION WORK AND, INASMUCH AS THE AGRICULTURAL STATES NEED ROADS DEVELOPED AND THE PEOPLE GET MORE BENEFIT FROM ROAD DEVELOPMENT THAN FROM ANY OTHER FORM OF FEDERAL EXPENDITURE FROM THE INDUSTRIAL RECOVERY ACT MONEY, I AM URGING SECRETARY ICKES TO APPORTION ANOTHER ALLOTMENT TO THE STATES FOR HIGHWAY DEVELOPMENT EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT ALREADY AVAILABLE, AND I AM ASKING THE GOVERNORS OF THE AGRICULTURAL STATES OF THE MIDDLE WEST IF THEY AGREE WITH ME TO IMMEDIATELY SEND A TELEGRAM TO SECRETARY ICKES URGING THAT AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF MONEY BE ASSIGNED TO THE VARIOUS STATES FOR ADDITIONAL ROAD DEVELOPMENT.
