I entered active service 12-16.43 Was with 3545 Boms Sq. 915 Boms Sq. as tall gumm. Aircraft disabled over Sermony 11-26-44. Captured by farmers and turned over to Sectopho, spending 3 days in undergrowd jail not seeing anyon, finally taker to interrogation center when they alternately blew hat and the cold air into cell. transfered to Stolog Juff TV, which a group of we left in January 1945, marching with a group until liberated 41-26, 1945. Separated from service 11-10-45.
