I entered active service 12-16-43 with
354th Bomb Sq. 91st Bomb Sq. as tail gunner. Aircraft
disabled over Germany 11-26-44. Captured by farmers
and turned over to Gestapo, spending 3 days in underground jail
not seeing anyone, finally taken to interrogation center where
they alternately blew hot and then cold air into cell.
Transferred to Stalag Luft IV, which a group of us left
in January 1945, marching with a group until liberated
4-26, 1945. Separated from service 11-10-45.
