Dear Mr. Simon:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of April 25 asking for consideration of your rights at Elbowoods.

I have had a similar letter from Mrs. Audrey Twilling. In my opinion, this is only another proof of the unreasonable attitude of the Army Engineers in dealing with the people of your area.

I certainly feel that you are entitled to compensation for your relocation costs. I will do what I can for you, but believe that Congressman Lene is in a little better position to help you because of his membership on the Public Lands committee which deals with these matters.

I am referring your letter and ~~Mrs. Twilling's~~ ^{Elbowoods} ~~letter~~ ^{to him} and assuring him of my support of anything he might be able to do in this matter. I certainly hope he will be able to secure some compensation for you. We will do our best.
