Open Access and Quasi-OER

- CC-licensed materials outside of OER repositories can still count as OER!
- Free to access \neq OER

OER ≠ Free Online Textbooks



- Don't expect to find an OER doppelgänger for your favorite commercial textbook
 - Introductory level OER easier to find than advanced level
 - OER may not have the specific features or organization you like

Affordances of OER



- Retain: You have the right to access, keep, and copy the resource
- Reuse: You yourself can make use of a resource again and again
 - Some CC license terms may restrict the specific contexts in which you can use a resource

Affordances of OER



- Revise: You have the right to change the contents of a resource
 - Write new passages, add new images, reorganize chapters!
 - Localize the resource to suit your special circumstances
 - Items with a “no derivatives” CC license are not considered true OER for this reason

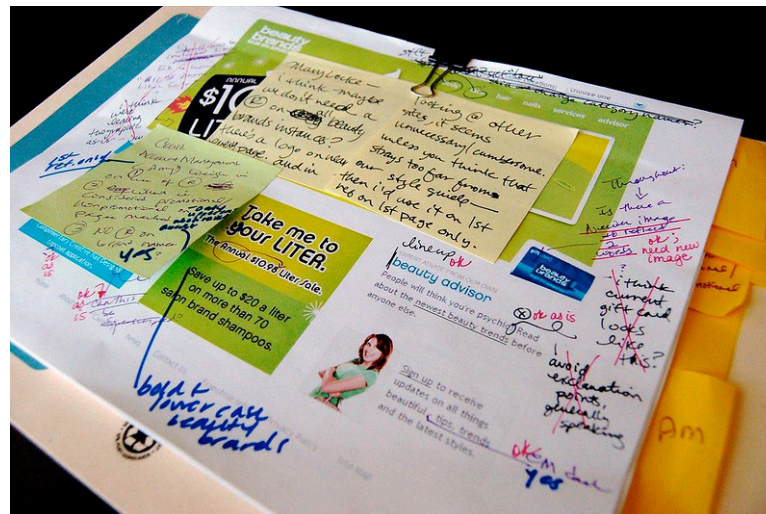

Affordances of OER

- Remix: You have the right to combine resources into something new and original
 - Create a new(-ish) OER by mixing and matching your favorite bits of existing OER
 - Platforms like LibreTexts have tools that help with remixing



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OER Affordances



- Redistribute: You have the right to share copies of a resource in its original, revised, or remixed form
 - Add OER to other repositories
 - It may feel funny to share and reproduce someone else's work, but it's OK with OER

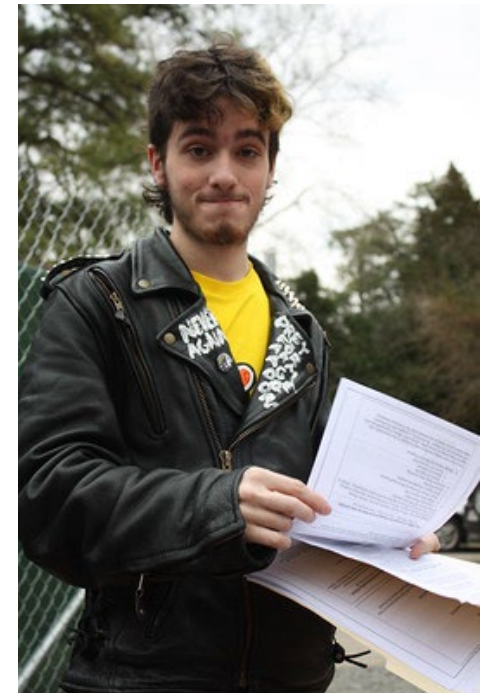

What's an "Inclusive Access"?



- Automatic textbook billing
 - Students who register for a course are charged directly to their bursar bill for the required materials
 - Students may opt-out of the program before the bill is sent
 - Students have access to the material on the first day of school or earlier
- Provided course material is essentially "rented" and access is lost once the course is over

The Airing of Grievances



- Technical difficulties
- Viability of opt-out windows
- Reduction of consumer options
- Quibbles over actual student savings
- General complaints regarding digital content
