Dear Mr. Montclair:

Thank you for your letter of November 9 and the resolution you enclosed issued by the Three Affiliated Tribes in council assembled, and held in the Community Hall at Elbowoods on November 3.

I have forwarded your message to Congressman Burdick who is presently at Williston, and it is possible he may write you directly from there. Particular attention is directed to the following quote from your letter:

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Council of the Fort Berthold Reservation shall authorize per capita payment of their private shares plus interest to each enrolled member of the Fort Berthold Reservation out of any available portion of the foregoing \$7,500,000."
