My dear Governor:

Pursuant to the provisions of the statutes of the State of Wisconsin, the Governor is required to appoint a member of the Grain and Warehouse Commission, and is directed to consult the Governors of the States of New York and North Dakota and the Board of Trade of the City of Superior.
