December 3, 1970

There being no corrections, the minutes of the November 5, 1970, meeting were ordered approved as submitted.

4.

Mr. Lund, on second reading, moved to amend the Senate By-Laws as follows:

"Section VI under Membership of the Senate be revised to provide for the election of fourteen student members to the University Senate; the starting date and duration will be provided for by the Student Senate."

The motion was seconded and discussion followed. Mr. Cushman moved to close discussion and vote immediately. It was seconded, voted upon and carried by the two-thirds majority. Miss Oslund requested that the vote on the main motion be by ballot. Mr. Lund objected. Miss Oslund moved that the vote on the main motion be by ballot. It was seconded, voted upon and carried. The vote by

ballot on the motion to amend the By-Laws was taken and lost by 26-27.

5.

Mr. Ulven presented the attached list of Candidates for Degrees in December, 1970, and moved that they be approved for recommendation to the State Board of Higher Education for the awarding of the degrees indicated, upon satisfactory completion of the work of the present semester. The motion was voted upon and carried. (See Attachment #1).

6.

Representing the Curriculum Committee in the absence of its chairman, Mr. Koenker presented the report of that committee on new courses and course changes at the Graduate level. Mr. Koenker moved their approval. It was seconded, voted upon and carried. (See Attachment #2).

7.

Mr. Ford moved an addition to the Standing Rules of the Senate that:  
"Reports of University Committees may be presented to the Senate by committee chairmen who are not members of the Senate."  
The motion was seconded, voted upon, and carried.

8.

The Chair called for nominations for the election of one Senate member to the Senate Executive Committee for a term of one year. Mr. Rognlie reported the nominations of Mr. Flynn and Mr. Krueger by the Committee on Committees. Mrs. Russell was nominated from the floor. It was moved, seconded, voted upon and carried that nominations cease. Mr. Flynn was elected.

9.

The Chair called for nominations for the election of one Senate member to the Codification Committee for a term of one year. Mr. Rognlie reported the nominations of Mr. Ford and Mr. Reiten by the Committee on Committees. Mr. Rushing was nominated from the floor. It was moved, seconded, voted upon and carried that nominations cease. Mr. Rushing was elected.

10.

The Chair called for nominations for the election of four faculty members of the Senate to the Administrative Procedures Committee for terms of one year. Mr. Rognlie reported the nominations of Miss Oslund, Mr. Owens, Mr. Sturges, Mr. Tweton, and Mr. Wright by the Committee on Committees. Mrs. Facey was nominated from the floor. Miss Oslund withdrew her name. It was moved, seconded, voted upon and carried that nominations cease. Mr. Owens, Mr. Sturges, Mr. Tweton, and Mr. Wright were elected.

11.

The Chair called for nominations for the election of four Senate members to The Committee on Committees for terms of one year. Mr. Rognlie reported the nominations of Mr. Apanian, Mr. Kraus, Mrs. MacKichan, Mr. Omdahl, and Mr. Stenberg. Mr. Rushing and Mr. Peterson were nominated from the floor. Mr. Stenberg withdrew his name. It was moved, seconded, voted upon and carried that nominations cease. Mr. Apanian, Mr. Kraus, Mrs. MacKichan, and Mr. Omdahl were elected.

12.

Mr. Kraus moved that the University Senate recognize the excellent service D. Jerome Tweton gave the University of North Dakota while he was Chairman of the Senate and commends his conscientious performance of the duties of his office. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
