MINUTES OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE MEETING

December 7, 1972

1.

The December meeting of the University Senate was held at 4:00 p.m., Thursday, December 7, 1972, in Room 7, Gamble Hall. Mr. Peterson presided.

There being no corrections, the minutes of the meeting of November 2, 1972, were ordered approved as submitted.

Mr. Kolstoe moved the adoption of the following proposed amendment to the Senate By-laws (presented for first reading at the November meeting):

Meetings

1. Items for the agenda shall be in the hands of the Registrar not later than ten days (exclusive of holidays) before a Senate Meeting. The agenda shall be distributed one full week before each Senate meeting to all faculty and student body representatives. Items not included in the agenda may not be considered at a meeting except with the special consent of the Senate. Only members of the Senate may submit items for the agenda.

Mrs. Clark seconded the motion. The motion was voted upon and carried.

5.

Mr. Ulven presented the attached list of Candidates for Degrees in December, 1972, and moved that they be approved for recommendation to the State Board of Higher Education for the awarding of the degrees indicated, upon satisfactory completion of the work of the present semester. The motion was seconded by Mr. Stenberg, voted upon and carried.

6.

Mr. Peterson called the attention of the Senate to the procedure to be followed in regard to the proposed amendment to the University of North Dakota Constitution. The item in the December agenda constitutes notice of consideration of such change. The proposed amendment must then be approved by the University legislature at two regular meetings by a majority of those present at those meetings before forwarding to the State Board of Higher Education for final approval. Mr. Lewis called attention to slight modifications in wording which will be made in the January presentation.

7.

Mr. Lewis moved that the Chairman of the University Senate request that the Codification Committee of the Senate, or some other appropriate committee, be instructed to prepare revisions of the Senate By-laws to permit earlier organization of the Senate in accordance with the new school calendar and that such revisions include consideration of electing Senators at the end of the school term, perhaps in April, instead of in the fall. Mr. Thorson seconded the motion. Mr. Kraus moved to amend the motion by adding that the committee must report back to the Senate before the March, 1973, meeting. Miss Heyse seconded the motion to amend. The motion to amend was voted upon and carried. The original motion, as amended was voted upon and carried.

Mr. Omdahl reported on the following appointments by the Committee on Committees to fill unexpired terms:

- 1. John Peterson to fill the unexpired term of C.W. Bullard on the Curriculum Committee.
- 2. Valborg Oslund to fill the unexpired term of C.W. Bullard on the Honorary Degrees Committee.

9.

The Chair called for nominations for the election of four faculty members to the Administrative Procedures Committee. Mr. Omdahl presented the nominations from the Committee on Committees as follows: Mr. Alberts, Mr. Iseminger, Mr. Jarman, Mr. Stenberg, and Mr. Thomforde. The Chair asked for nominations from the floor and since there were none, declared nominations closed. A ballot was taken and Mr. Alberts, Mr. Iseminger, Mr. Jarman and Mr. Thomforde were elected.

10.

The Chair called for nominations for the election of one Senate member to the Codification Committee. Mr. Omdahl reported the nomination of Mr. Rushing by the Committee on Committees. The Chair asked for nominations from the floor and since there were none, a ballot was taken and Mr. Rushing was elected.

11.

The Chair called for nominations for the election of four Senate members to the Committee on Committees. Mr. Brumleve, Mrs. MacKichan, Mr. Marti, Mr. Murray and Mr. Omdahl were nominated by the Committee on Committees. The Chair asked for nominations from the floor and since there were none, declared nominations closed. A ballot was taken and Mr. Brumleve, Mrs. MacKichan, Mr. Murray and Mr. Omdahl were elected.

12.

Mr. Kolstoe moved that the Senate approve the following new courses:

Aviation 330 Introduction to Weather Modification 4 cr.

Aviation 340 Advanced Weather Modification 4 cr.

Aviation 390 Aviation Internship 2-4 cr.

Mr. Alberts seconded the motion. Discussion followed. In the course of the discussion, Mr. Kraus moved and Mr. Russell Brown seconded to permit Mr. Ralph Brown and Mr. Odegard to speak to the Senate regarding this issue.

This motion was voted upon and carried. Mr. Odegard and Mr. Ralph Brown addressed the Senate. Mr. Tomasek moved that we vote on the main motion. Mrs. Clark seconded the motion to vote. This motion was voted upon and carried. The motion to approve the three courses was voted upon and carried.

13.

"Mr. Peterson asked the Senate to consider a change of date for the January meeting as school will not be in session on the first Thursday. Mr. DiBrito moved that the meeting date be set for January 18, 1973. Mr. Kannowski seconded the motion. The motion was voted upon and carried.

14.

Mr. Jarman moved for adjournment. Mr. Stenberg seconded the motion. The motion was voted upon and carried and the meeting adjourned at 5:04 p.m.
