SUMMARY (Indicate page nos.):

During a thrust forward from Bolobolka by units of 5 divisions 115 bandits were killed and 14 captured. 10 bandits were summarily shot (standrechtlich erschossen) and a badit leader was shot during flight after interrogation. Countless ammunition blew up in the houses which were set on fire by shooting.

Destination

In the combat against the bands from 9 August to 9 September 1942 under the command of Luftwaffe Division (moto-mized), fought by units of the 18th Inf. Division (moto-rized), 20th Inf. Div. (Mot.),5th Jaeger Div., 218th Div. and Luftw. Div. MEINDL, the land-spit as far as Serbolowo and raporotno (starting from Belebelka) and the land-spit up to Bol. Goroditschne, between Ssusseljiniza and Patinez (starting from Ssokolje) were seized.

Own losses: 5 dead (by mines), 17 wounded.
The bandits lost: 1.5 dead, 14 prisoners, 1 deserter.
The bandits shot summarily (standrechtlich) and the band leader ILJIN was shot after interrogation when trying to escape.

Booty made: 1-4,5 ctm antitank gun, 1-3,7 ctm antitank gun, 1 antitank rirle, 1 mortar, 1 spade-mortar, 1 light machine gun, 7 machine pistols, more than 90 rifles, 5,900 rounds of Soviet Russian ammunition, 22,400 rounds of ITP ammunition (R), 2,300 rounds of American HG ammunition, 366 stick hand-grenades, 454 cgg-shaped hand-grenades, 378 rounds of antitank rifle ammunition,

650 light mortar shells (1), 190 kg explosives, many detonators and fuzes, 170 mine detonator-fuzes, 8 electric mines, 50 winter-camouflage jackets (German), about 50 horses, 150 head of cattle, many goats and geese. The land-spit on both sides of Ssapolje is very abundant in trye, oats and potatoes.

lot of ammunition went up with the houses set on fire by artillery fire, also 2 small ammunition piles in Ssusseljiniza.
