## MINUTES OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE MEETING

December 5, 1974

1.

The December meeting of the University Senate was held at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 5, 1974, in room 7, Gamble Hall. Mr. Markovich presided.

There being no corrections, the minutes of the November 7 meeting were approved as submitted.

4.

Mr. Markovich asked if there would be any objection to considering item #4 on the agenda as the first item of business. There being no objection, the change of date for the January Senate meeting was discussed. Mr. Penn moved that the meeting be held on Thursday, January 16, 1975, at 4:00, with agenda items due by Monday, January 6, at 4:00. Mr. Ford seconded the motion and the motion was voted upon and carried.

5.

Mr. Markovich announced that item #8, Proposed Policy Statement on Student Records, has been withdrawn from the agenda.

6.

Mr. Fletcher reported for the Committee on Evaluation of Administrators. He stated that this Committee is working on the project and will submit a report to the Senate at a later date.

7.

Mr. Ulven presented the attached list of Candidates for Degrees in December, 1974, and moved that the list be approved for recommendation to the State Board of Higher Education for the awarding of the degrees indicated, upon satisfactory completion of the degree requirements. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried.

8.

Mr. Murray, Chairman of the Committee on Committees, presented the nominations of the Committee on Committees for the faculty positions on the Administrative Procedures Committee, the Committee on Committees and the Codification Committee. Mr. Penn moved that tabulation of the ballots be accomplished after adjournment and that the results be announced through the University Newsletter. Ms. Heyse seconded the motion. The motion was voted upon and carried. The following were nominated for four positions on the Administrative Procedures Committee: Agnes Shurr, John Williams, Edward Nelson, Tom Rand, LaVonne Russell and Ernest Norman. The Chair called for additional nominations from the floor. Since there were no further nominations from the floor, the Chair declared nominations closed. A ballot was taken and Mr. Williams, Mr. Nelson, Ms. Russell and Mr. Norman were elected as members of the Administrative Procedures Committee.

9.

The Chair called for the election of four members to the Committee on Committees. The following were nominated: Gerald Potter, Beulah Hedahl, Steven Harlow, David Ramsett, Lee Kraft and Ronald Bzoch. The Chair called for additional

nominees from the floor. Since there were no further nominations, the Chair declared nominations closed. A ballot was taken and Mr. Potter, Ms. Hedahl, Mr. Ramsett and Mr. Bzoch were declared elected as members of the Committee on Committees.

10.

The Chair called for the election of one member to the Codification Committee. The following were nominated: Larry Kraft and Thomas Lockney. The Chair called for additional nominees from the floor. Since there were no further nominations, the Chair declared nominations closed and a ballot was taken. Mr. Kraft was elected as a member of the Codification Committee.

11.

Mr. Ulven moved to rescind University Senate action of November 2, 1967, which prohibits pre-registration except summer registration for new freshmen and transfer students. Mr. Jarman seconded the motion. The Senate requested that Mr. Ulven give a brief outline of the proposed new system and discussion followed. The motion was voted upon and carried.

12.

Mr. Ralph Brown, Chairman of the Academic Policies Committee, presented the following recommendation regarding repeated courses: "A student who receives a grade of D or F may repeat the course. Courses in which grades of C or better are earned may be repeated upon written approval of the student's Academic Dean. The last grade achieved in each course is to be used in calculating the student's grade point average. To raise a grade other than F or U, a student may have the alternative of taking a re-examination at the time of the first regularly scheduled examination in the subject if it meets with the approval of the department concerned and with the student's dean and advisor." Ms. Behringer moved approval of the recommendation and Mr. O'Kelly seconded the motion. Discussion followed. Mr. Rowe moved to amend the second sentence by striking the words, "upon written approval of the student's Academic Dean." The motion to amend was seconded and discussion followed. Mr. Strentz asked Mr. Rowe if he would be agreeable to change the second sentence to read, "upon written notification to the Registrar's Office by the student." Further discussion followed. Mr. Reid moved a substitute motion to amend the motion by changing the second sentence to read, "upon written approval of the department concerned and the student's dean and academic advisor." The motion to amend was seconded. Discussion followed and the substitute motion to amend was voted upon and carried. Mr. Ingstad moved to change the first sentence of the recommendation to read, "A student who wishes to repeat a course, may repeat the course upon the written approval of the department concerned and the student's dean and academic advisor." Mr. Shermoen seconded the motion. Mr. Iseminger moved to suspend the standing rule of the Senate regarding the 5:30 adjournment time until action on this item is completed.

The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried. A motion was made to vote immediately on the question. This motion was seconded, voted upon and carried. Mr. Ingstad's motion was voted upon and lost. Mr. Rowe moved to divide the question and to vote on the first portion which reads, as amended: "A student who receives a grade of D or F may repeat the course. Courses in which grades of C or better are earned may be repeated upon written approval of the department concerned and the student's dean and academic advisor. Mr. Reid seconded the motion. Mr. O'Kelly moved to vote immediately on the motion. The motion to vote immediately was seconded, voted upon and carried. The first portion of the question was voted upon and carried. Discussion continued on the second part of the question. Mr. Iseminger moved that the following be referred back to the Academic Policies Committee: "To raise a grade other than F or U, a student may have the alternative of taking a re-examination at the time of the first regularly scheduled examination in the subject if it meets with the approval of the department concerned and with the student's dean and advisor." Mr. Tomasek seconded the motion. The motion to refer was voted upon and carried.

13.

Mr. Tomasek moved that the meeting adjourn and the motion was seconded by Mr. Ford. The motion was voted upon and carried. The meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
