Dear Mr. Keller:

In the absence of Congressman Burdick I am acknowledging your letter of May 27th concerning the per capita payments for the Indians.

So far as I know, there is no reason why your younger daughter should not have gotten her payment at the same time your oldest daughter got hers. From the information we get here it would seem that the Tribal Council or whoever has charge of making the payments does it largely on their own initiative and without a well organized or implemented system. I would suggest that you take up with the Tribal Council or the agency the matter of your younger daughter's payment. If you do not get it straightened out within a short time, please write us again, and we will see if we can get any results from this end.
