I am in receipt of your favor of the 22nd instant relative to law violations at Woonon and wish to thank you for writing me in regard to the matter.

The matter will be investigated at a very early date.

It will help expedite matters if you will send me the names of those whom you have reason to believe are violating the liquor and gambling laws. Would like to have a list of those running gambling places and blind pigs as well as a list of men who frequent such places. This information will be of very great help to us in getting quick action and, of course, any information you send us will be kept strictly confidential.
