# MINUTES OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE MEETING

#### May 5, 1983

#### 1.

The May meeting of the University Senate was held at 4:05 p.m. on Thursday, May 5, 1983, in room 7, Gamble Hall. Richard Ludtke presided.

The Chair announced that since there was not a quorum at the scheduled special meeting of the Senate on April 14, the Senate Executive Committee formally notified the Vice president for Academic Affairs to procede with the preparation of the Faculty Handbook. The Chair stated that, as a follow-up of the Promotion Procedures Committee, the Senate Executive Committee, last September, established an ad hoc Committee on Promotion Appeal and Criteria and asked this committee to report back to the Senate in April. Tom Owens, Chair of the ad hoc Committee, wrote to the Executive Committee, attaching a copy of the recommendation of the prior committee on an appropriate appeals procedure and requested that this recommendation be considered. In response, this recommendation will be placed on the October Senate agenda. Mr. Owens also asked if the ad hoc Committee should review the criteria for promotion again since the criteria were revised as recently as June 1980. The Chair asked the sense of the Senate regarding another review of the criteria and an extension of the amount of time for the committee report. After discussion regarding looking into the uniformity among the colleges, Mr. Johnson moved that the ad hoc Committee continue working on the review of criteria. Ms. Hess seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried by a vote of 43 for and 4 abstaining.

4.

The Chair called for approval of the minutes of the April 7 meeting. Mr. Schwartz requested a correction in the wording of his motion on page 2385 by changing the word, "file," to "accept," so the motion will read: Mr. Schwartz moved to accept the report of the ad hoc Committee on Selection of Outstanding Teacher Awards. Mr. Lawrence Hill, who had seconded the motion, confirmed the correction. Mr. Tomasek moved to approve the minutes of the April meeting, as corrected. Mr. Brown seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried unanimously.

# 5.

Mr. Wermers presented the tentative list of Candidates for Degrees in May, 1983, and moved that the list be approved for recommendation to the State Board of Higher Education for the awarding of the degrees indicated, upon satisfactory completion of the work of the present semester. Mr. Henry seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried unanimously. (See attachment # 1.)

# 6.

Mr. Ludtke gave the second reading of the recommendation from the Senate Executive Committee to remove reference to all committees from the Senate Bylaws. Ms. Lambeth moved a friendly amendment to remove all committees from the Senate Bylaws except the Senate Executive Committee and the Codification Committee. Mr. Johnson seconded the motion. The Chair stated that if this change, as amended, is passed, the following committees will be removed from the Bylaws but will continue to exist as standing committees of the Senate: the Committee on Committees, Administrative Procedures Committee, Academic Policies Committee, and the Student Policies Committee. The motion to amend was voted upon and carried by a vote of 43 for and 4 abstaining. Discussion continued on the main motion. The question was asked, since this motion has been amended, does this constitute the first or the second reading. The Chair ruled that this constitutes the second reading and that the Senate vote on the motion, as amended. Mr. Gustafson appealed the ruling of the Chair. A vote was taken and 29 voted for this constituting a second reading, 16 were against and 2 abstained. The main motion, as amended, was voted upon and defeated by a vote of 22 for, 23 against and 2 abstaining.

Ms. Hess presented the annual report of the Faculty Research Committee and moved that the report be filed. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. The motion was voted upon and carried by a vote of 46 for and 1 abstaining. (See attachment # 2.)

Lucy Schwartz, Chair of the Curriculum Committee, presented the annual report of that Committee. Mr. Rowe moved the report be accepted. Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion. Discussion followed. The motion was voted upon and carried by a vote of 44 for and 2 abstaining. (See attachment # 3.)

## 9.

Lucy Schwartz presented the recommendation of the Curriculum Committee for new programs with new courses. Mr. Johnson moved to adopt the recommendation. Mr. Hampsten seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried by a vote of 44 for and 2 abstaining. (See attachment # 4.)

#### 10.

Mr. Bender presented the report of the ad hoc Committee to Define Eligibility for Election to the Senate. Mr. Ring moved adoption of the report. Mr. Hill seconded the motion. Discussion followed. The motion was voted upon and carried by a vote of 38 for, 3 against and 5 abstaining. (See attachment # 5.)

#### 11.

Mr. Johnson moved to adjourn. Ms. Hess seconded the motion which was voted upon and carried by a vote of 13 for and the remainder not marking the voting record. The meeting adjourned at 5:05 p.m.

The Constitution and By-laws of the University Senate (minutes of November 3, 1966; November 2, 1967; and April 9, 1968) charge the Committee to "stimulate and encourage faculty research, develop institutional policy on faculty research and to allocate research funds available to the Faculty Research Committee on the basis of applications submitted to it."

#### MEETINGS:

The Faculty Research Committee meets for two primary purposes:

- The evaluation of research and creative activity proposals from 1. UND faculty. These meetings are convened three times each year, usually in early November, late January, and early April.
- 2. Discussion of UND policies related to research and discussion of ways to encourage more research at this University. This past year, three such meetings were convened for this purpose.

## FUNDS:

During the 1981-82 academic year, the Faculty Research Committee awarded \$41,350.00 to faculty and staff members. Grants were awarded to 64 recipients from 29 academic departments and to one library staff member. During the 1982-83 academic year, applications were reviewed in November, February and April. A total of \$42,542.40 was awarded to 67 faculty members in 22 departments. The grants ranged in amounts from \$50.00 to \$2600.00.

#### OTHER ACTIVITIES:

- 1. The Faculty Research Committee reviewed and approved statements from various departments and BICs concerning the use of Institutional Research Funds.
- 2. Both the chairman and the Faculty Research Committee as a whole served as informal consultants to Dr. Alice Clark, VPAA, in her task of formulating a policy concerning Bureaus, Institutes and Centers.
- 3. Professors Hess, McElroy and Stinnett served on the Faculty Development Committee, representing the Faculty Research Committee.
- 4. Professors Crawford and Wright represented the Faculty Research Committee in the selection of the recipient of the Departmental Award for Research Excellence.

NUMBER OF MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE

Twenty-seven full committee meetings were held during the period from August 30, 1982 to April 18, 1983. Additional sub-committee meetings were held to design instruction sheets for the new UND curriculum forms and to confer with the chairs of the curriculum committees of the colleges.

#### GENERAL ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMITTEE

The committee reviewed and acted upon undergraduate and graduate course and program proposals. Twelve courses were dropped and eighty-four minor changes in existing courses were approved. These minor course changes were reported in the University Newsletter and forwarded as Agenda "B" items to the North Dakota Board of Higher Education, according to defined procedures. In addition the committee approved ten changes in program requirements and the change in title of two majors. These items were also listed in the University Newsletter and reported to the North Dakota Board of Higher Education.

The thirty-three new course proposals approved by the committee were presented to the Senate for action. After approval by the Senate, the courses were sent to the North Dakota Board of Higher Education according to their prescribed procedures, at their November and April meetings. The seven new program proposals (two majors, two minors, and 3 graduate programs) approved by the committee were presented for Senate action. These programs have been approved by the Senate, and have been forwarded to the North Dakota State Board of Higher Education. The Master of Arts degree in Anthropology has not been forwarded, although approved, pending identification of required resources.

#### Curriculum Committee page 2

At the request of the VPAA, the committee reviewed the procedures relating to the evaluation of undergraduate programs at UND. The committee intends to submit a report to the VPAA before the end of the academic year. The committee is developing procedures for evaluation of the undergraduate programs based on Senate policy for implementation by the colleges.

The committee attempted, following the recommendations of the Boyd Wright Task Force on Committees, to improve communication with college curriculum committees. A representative from the sub-committee that developed the University Curriculum Committee forms met with the chair of each college curriculum committee to explain the procedures for the UND and State Board forms. The sub-committee contributed input for the revision of the State Board forms as requested by the VPAA office.

The committee has published guidelines and deadlines for curriculum requests in the University Newsletter and has communicated them directly with deans, chairpersons, and program directors. Because of the catalogue deadlines for 1984, any new courses which are to appear in the catalogue must be approved by the Senate in October 1983 in order to meet the deadlines of the North Dakota Board of Higher Education. Thus the Curriculum Committee must receive any such requests as soon as possible after classes begin in August of 1983.

The Senate Ad hoc committee appointed at the November 1982 University Senate meeting held a series of meetings this academic year to define "Faculty Eligibility For Election to the Senate". The committee members were as follows:

The major objective of the committee was to provide an <u>interpretation</u> of the University Constitution and Senate Bylaws regarding the definition of faculty for the purpose of serving on the University Council and Senate.

Reference to Faculty in The University of North Dakota Constitution (II. The University Legislature #1. Legislative Bodies pp. 1 & 2).

- a. The University Legislature shall consist of the Council and its Senate.
- b. The Council consists of the following, who are employed primarily on the Grand Forks campus: The President, the Vice Presidents, the Director of Admissions and Records, the Director of Libraries, all deans, all department chairpersons, all of the <u>full-time faculty</u> of the rank of instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, and professor, the Director of the Counseling Center, the professional library staff, and <u>such other academic personnel and administrative</u> officers as the Council may designate.
- c. The Senate shall consist of the following members:
  - Ex-Officio Members: The President, the Vice Presidents, the Director of Admissions and Records, the Director of Libraries, all deans, and the Coordinator of the Honors Program.
  - (2) Faculty Members: The Council shall provide by legislation for the election of Council members to the Senate, for such terms and in such manner as the Council shall determine, but subject to these limitations: (1) no one may be eligible for election to the Senate who shall not have been a member of the Council for one full academic year; (2) the total number of elected faculty members of the Senate shall not be less than

two times the number of ex-officio members; (3) the faculty of each school or college shall have the right to elect to the Senate at least one of its members who are eligible for election to the Senate.

# Reference To Faculty In By-Laws of the University Senate: (Under Membership #1. p. one)

"The University Senate shall consist of the following: Ex Officio members, faculty members elected by the faculty, student members elected by the students.

The total number of Faculty Senate members elected by the faculties at large shall not be less than two times the number of ex officio members. The Faculty of each school or college shall elect one Senate member; the balance of the faculty membership of the Senate shall be elected at large by the Council."

## Senate Ad hoc Committee Recommendation:

In defining membership on the University Council, the Constitution of the University says that "all of the full-time faculty of the rank of instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, and professor" are members of the Council by virtue of their rank. The authoritative source for determining the nature of a person's appointment shall be the title of the appointment designated on the university contract of employment. In determining who is eligible, as a consequence of faculty rank, to vote as a Council member or stand for elective offices in the University Senate or on Senate committees, possession of these designated titles of rank shall be decisive.

#### IMPLICATION:

1. When the contract indicates the person is appointed as a faculty member and to some other position--as in coach/professor or associate professor/ director--that shall be prima facie evidence that the person is not considered as holding a full-time faculty position and therefore, shall not be eligible for Council membership by virtue of faculty rank. When the title differs from the four cited titles the holder of the rank shall also be assumed to be ineligible, e.g., clinical professors, visiting professors, adjunct professors, lecturers, etc.

2. It is inappropriate to use the designation of faculty rank on the contract to indicate duties. If, for instance, a position is offered with the understanding that it carries with it full-time faculty status with all relevant responsibilities and privileges and that one designated responsibility is clinical in nature, that fact should be indicated in the terms of the contract rather than in the title. On the other hand, if the title is meant to indicate the person shall be excluded from certain responsibilities, e.g., participation in governance, or certain privileges, e.g., eligibility for tenure, then it is appropriate that the title give grounds for denying Council membership. This description of job responsibilities should make clear what the University expects of the person in question, and should meet the needs of any outside agency which demands certain kinds of personnel be on staff to satisfy grant requirements or other considerations extraneous to the University's system of designating rank and eligibility for Council membership.

3. The following titles are currently being used for faculty appointment purposes by the University. Faculty members having such titles are ineligible to serve on the Council or Senate:

4. When the title on the contract is intended to indicate the person in question is not a full-time faculty member, e.g., adjunct professor, or the appointment is in fact intended to be a temporary appointment, e.g., visiting professor, then this intent should be clearly understood by the person in question, and it should be understood that such designation renders the person ineligible for Council membership.

#### IMPLEMENTATION:

The Senate should have a choice, depending on the information supplied by appropriate administrative officers (President, Vice-President, and Deans), as to whether this practice can be implemented prior to the next election of Senate members, or whether it should be delayed until the issuance of contracts for 1984. If possible, it should be initiated effective with the commencement of the fall semester, 1983, but in no case later than the fall semester, 1984.
