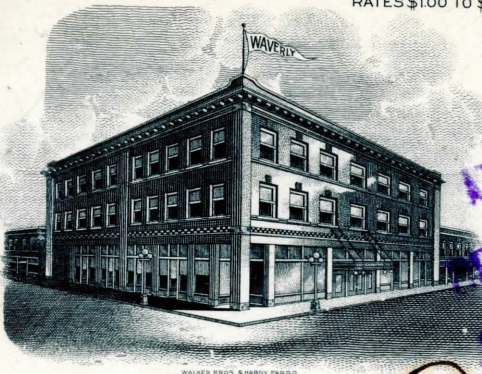

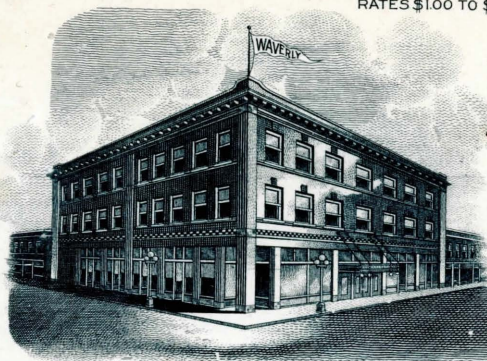

 be able to make some



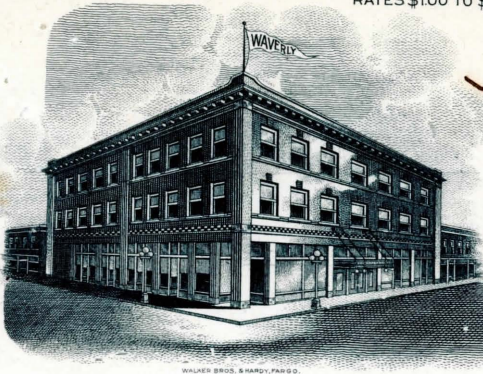
