Dear Mrs. Machado:

On April 27 I sent a telegram to the Superintendent of the Fort Berthold Reservation and asked for a report on the reasons your children have not been permitted to be enrolled in the tribe. I received the letter, of which I enclose a copy, from Mr. Shane a few days ago.

From his report it appears to me that this is a matter which can be straightened out only by the Tribal Council, and the only way I know is to try to get the required seven votes which are necessary for their admittance. I will take this up with the Chairman of the Council and see if I can get any action that way. When I have his reply you may expect to hear from me further.
