Amendment to "Statement on Administrator Responsibilities"

The term "administrator" as used in this statement applies to the following positions at the University of North Dakota: the President, the Vice-Presidents, the Deans, the Department Chairmen and other directors of University programs and functions. The Statement on Faculty Responsibilities, adopted by the University Senate on November 4, 1971, applies equally to those administrators who exercise teaching responsibilities and/or hold faculty rank.

The University administrator has responsibilities in most of the following areas: financial administration, faculty and personnel administration, administration of the educational program, relationships with students, responsibilities as a teacher, responsibilities with his or her colleagues for the committee work of the University, the promotion of extracurricular activities within the area of his or her concern, and the provision of services to his or her profession and to the public. In order to discharge these responsibilities, two essentials must prevail: The administrator has the responsibility for defining in writing and publishing where appropriate the scope of work and the duties of those who are responsible to him or her. Authority to discharge these duties must be commensurate with the responsibilities assigned.

To attempt to insure that each administrator with faculty status continues and maintains (1) his or her responsibilities as a teacher and (2) his or her awareness of the nature of the student body and of the faculty's pedagogic concerns, each administrator with faculty status should teach a course in his or her discipline (and preferably on the undergraduate level) at least once a year.

The University administrator should adhere to the following principles of democratic administration:

1. Respect for individuals.
2. Faith in the power of human intelligence to solve problems.
3. The right of each individual affected by policy formation or alteration to have an equitable part in the determination of that policy.
4. The right to act through his or her chosen representatives.
5. The right to equality of opportunity.
6. The exercise of fairness.
7. The right of each individual to appeal decisions and actions affecting him and the right of the individual to be informed of avenues of appeal.

In the exercise of these basic principles, the administrator should nurture an atmosphere of mutual trust and honesty based on good communication.

The administrator also has a unique responsibility to keep abreast of the developments in his or her administrative field and to exercise leadership which encourages innovation and the development of receptivity to new ideas. As a leader the administrator functions within his or her group as its spokesman, harmonizer, planner, executive, educator and symbol of its ideals. TO: University Senate

FROM: The Committee to Study Coordination of University-Wide Programming
of Cultural and Entertainment Events

On the basis of its investigation of the possibilities of coordination and recognizing that the University is well-served by having a variety of interest groups programming cultural events on campus, the Committee respectfully submits the following recommendations for coordination of university-wide programming.

1. Retain the autonomous structure of each of the present programming groups with respect to the selection of programs in its area of interest and increase student participation in programming decisions so that the students and faculty may, for the University and the Community, increase enjoyment of cultural and entertainment events in our expanded and excellent physical plant facilities.

2. Establish a program coordinating committee to oversee cultural and entertainment programming on campus, coordinate with off-campus groups, work to resolve conflicts, recommend compromises, develop harmonious relations among all groups scheduling cultural programs, formulate policy, and periodically review programming.

The committee should be composed of representation from each of the major programming groups or committees: Convocations, Upson, Fine Arts, Student Center Board of Governors, Chester Fritz Auditorium Committee, Faculty Lectures, Theatre, Art, Music and Dance. The committee should also include a professional staff member (e.g., a director of university programming) to be used as a resource person by all groups scheduling programs.

3. Create the office of director of university program coordination. The director should report to the coordinating committee, serve it as the professional resource person, and assist it in bringing about the performance of selected programs.

Functions of this office should include: (a) Maintenance of an activities calendar for the Greater Grand Forks area and dissemination of advance information on scheduled programs to campus program groups; (b) transmittal of notices of possible program duplication and schedule conflicts to the appropriate program planning groups; (c) liaison between the university programming organizations and those which are off-campus; (d) negotiation of contract terms with professional entertainers within guidelines established by the groups who have selected the entertainers; (e) assistance to program groups in promotion and completion of on-campus arrangements for cultural and entertainment events; (f) reservation of major campus facilities for proposed events; and (g) regular reporting to and meeting with the program coordinating committee. The Committee is cognizant of the paucity of funds available to support new job positions. There are, however, persons on the University Center and Chester Fritz staffs who now perform a number of these activities which could be more effectively handled in the manner recommended by the Committee. A realignment of functions among these persons might enable one person to assume responsibilities for program coordination on a part-time basis at least.

4. Require the sponsorship of each cultural or entertainment event by an appropriate University Organization or faculty-student programming committee. The presentation of an event with wide community and university appeal, for which no sponsoring organization now exists, should be sponsored by the Chester Fritz Auditorium Committee (or the Program Coordinating Committee) and be designated by a title reserved for those events, such as "A Com-U-Pop Event".

It is hoped that the University Senate will forward to its Committee on Committees the following suggestions for further study.

1. Attempt to more clearly define the program responsibilities of each of the major programming groups so as to reduce duplication in programming.
2. Begin a thorough study of the financing of cultural programs which will include a search for alternative funding for programs of high overhead cost.

3. Incorporate the Upson Lecture Committee into the Convocations and Lectures Committee. There appears to be little need to maintain two committees, with the attendant problems of coordination, which program similar events to similar audiences. If distinction must be accorded to the Upson lectures, an Upson Subcommittee of the Convocations and Lectures Committee could be created. In addition, consideration should be given to the eventual inclusion of the Faculty Lectures Committee in the Convocations and Lectures Committee.
4. Plan the Upson Lectureship as a single annual event of considerable distinction. Require the person chosen as an Upson lecturer to deliver an original discourse oriented to the particular concerns of North Dakotans. As an additional stipulation, the lecturer should consent to the publication of his speech in an appropriate journal of the University. At present, there is little difference between an Upson-sponsored lecture and one programmed by some other organization.

During the course of its evaluation of programming, the Committee to Study Coordination of Programming acquired information on the roles of the major programming committees, their activities, and sources of funding. A report which contains this information has been filed with the Secretary of the University Senate.
