A BILL

To provide for certain per capita payments to members of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, North Dakota.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That when the Secretary of the Interior determines that the
- 4 purposes of sections 2 and 12 of the joint resolution entitled
