I am sure you have our opinion or objection on small payment through our Chairman, Mr. Martin Cross, because the present existing Bill S. 2151 will serve similar purpose. So we are anxious to have you expedite the passage of present Bill S. 2151.

I would like to inform you that our census roll was approved and certified by Secretary of Interior on 22nd of September, 1954. Wewill only make supplement roll for payment, which is now prepared for that purpose.
