CHESTER FRITZ DISTINGUISHED PROFESSORS

The Chester Fritz Distinguished Professorships were established with an endowment gift from the late UND benefactor Chester Fritz, 1892-1983. Revenue from the endowment provides for cash stipends to one or more full-time UND faculty members, who thereafter may use the title "Chester Fritz Distinguished Professor." Nominations are solicited from members of the Council of Deans and the Chester Fritz Distinguished Professors; these are evaluated by a committee chaired by the graduate dean and composed of three Chester Fritz Distinguished Professors and faculty representatives from each academic college not represented by a Fritz Professor. The recommendations are reviewed by the Vice President for Academic Affairs and forwarded to the President for final decision.

Chester Fritz attended UND from 1908 to 1910. He became an international trader in precious metals and lived most of his life in China and Europe. In establishing the endowment for the professorships — just one of his many gifts to UND — as an "investment in the future of my Alma Mater and of the people who make the future what it shall be." He added, "I am especially indebted to the fine teachers who, in the end, have determined in large measure, how well I was able to learn and to use the knowledge that the University of North Dakota could provide.

ACADEMIC PAGEANTRY

The pageantry of American colleges and universities, including such ceremonies as commencement, has been inherited from the medieval universities of the 11th and 12th centuries. Academic life as it is known today began in the Middle Ages, first in the church and then in the guilds. The teaching guild was the Guild of the Master of Arts, in which the Bachelor was the apprentice of the Master and the dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility.

The ceremony you will witness today will be less formal than would have been the case even two decades ago. Still, many

traditions have been continued. To maintain continuity with the past, University of North Dakota faculty, the stage officials and the degree candidates will wear academic dress.

Principal features of academic garb are the gown, cap and hood. Early it became necessary for universities to set rules to preserve the dignity and meaning of academic dress. Both Cambridge and Oxford since the 15th century have made academic dress a matter of university control even to its minor details, and have repeatedly published revised regulations. American universities agreed on a definite system in 1895.

ACADEMIC DRESS

THE GOWN. The flowing gown comes from the 12th century. While it originally may have been worn as protection against the chill of unheated buildings, it has today become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any trappings of rank or social standing underneath. It is black for all degrees, with pointed sleeves for the bachelor's degree recipient, long closed sleeves with a slit at the arm or wrist for the master's degree, or full bell double sleeves for the doctoral degree. Bachelor's and master's degree gowns have no trimming. For the doctoral degree, the gown is faced down the front with velvet and has three bars of velvet across the sleeves in the color distinctive of the faculty or discipline to which the degree pertains.

THE CAP. Under Roman law, a slave that had been set free received the privilege of wearing a cap. The academic cap is a sign of freedom of scholarship, and of the responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Ancient poetry records the cap of scholarship as square to symbolize the book. The color of the tassel denotes the discipline. At the University of North Dakota, the tassel colors associated with

academic divisions are: **white**, College of Arts and Sciences; **drab** (subdued orange), College of Business and Public Administration; **black and white**, John D. Odegard School of Aerospace Sciences; **blue and white**, College of Education and Human Development; **orange**, School of Engineering and Mines; **purple**, School of Law; **green**, School of Medicine; **apricot**, College of Nursing; **black**, Graduate School. For undergraduate students, the tassels hang on the right side of the cap until they receive their degrees, at which time the tassel is moved to the left. For masters students, the tassel hangs on the left side of the cap and is not moved.

THE HOOD. The hood is trimmed with one or more chevrons of a secondary color on the ground of the primary color of the college. The color of the facing of the hood denotes the discipline represented by the degree; the color of the lining designates the university or college which granted the degree. The official colors of the University of North Dakota, selected by the student body in preparation for the institution's first commencement in 1889, are the pink and green of the prairie rose.

CEREMONIAL OBJECTS

THE MACE. The mace was initially modeled after a 12th-century implement of war. In earlier days, the mace, or heavy staff, was borne by or carried before a magistrate or other dignitary as an ensign of authority. A mace is placed as the symbol of royal authority on the treasury table in the British House of Commons at the opening of each session and is removed at its close. In the U.S. House of Representatives, it is a rather plain staff mounted in a marble pedestal at the right hand of the Speaker. The mace of the University of North Dakota symbolizes authority to carry out its mission, especially the granting of degrees. Made from the oak of the University's first building, "Old Main," the mace is carried by a marshal during academic processions and is placed at a prominent spot on the stage during commencement.

THE MEDALLION. A medallion or seal of office worn by the head of an educational institution is a practice that also dates to the Middle Ages. In those times, a seal was used to mark documents as official. Possession of the seal was so important that it was usually worn around the neck for safekeeping. The wearing of the seal eventually became a symbol of authority. One side of the medallion worn by the president bears an engraving of the University's official seal.

THE CHARTER. The University of North Dakota was founded six years before North Dakota became a state. The original, handwritten charter, enacted in 1883 by the Dakota Territorial Assembly, is preserved in UND's archives. One facsimile is displayed in the President's Office and another is used at commencements and other special occasions.

HONORARY DEGREES AWARDED

The University of North Dakota held its first commencement on June 13, 1889—the same year North Dakota became a state. Six women and two men received diplomas during a ceremony filled with oratory and reflection on the University's beginnings.

Honorary degrees have long been awarded by institutions of higher learning to recognize lives of achievement. In 1909 UND presented its first honorary degree, a Doctor of Laws, to Webster Merrifield, who served the University for 25 years, including 18 as its third president.

Honorary degrees from UND particularly recognize those with an association with the University or with the state and region; they also have been presented to such notables as philosopher Mortimer Adler, heart surgeon Michael DeBakey and President John F. Kennedy.

Rear Admiral Paul O. Soderberg was born in Willmar, Minnesota and grew up in Kenmare, North Dakota. He graduated from Minot State University (BS) in 1965 and holds Master of Science degrees from the University of North Dakota and from the Naval Post Graduate School. Additionally, he is a graduate from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, and the Advanced Management Program at the FUQUA School of Business, Duke University.

Rear Admiral Soderberg has served in a wide range of afloat and staff assignments. His sea tours include Supply Officer, USS HASSAYAMPA (AO 145) in Pearl Harbor, including deployments to the Western Pacific in support of Vietnam operations (1972-1974); Stock Control Officer on board USS MARS (AFS 1) in Alameda, California (1977-1979); and Supply Officer on board the aircraft carrier USS AMERICA (CV 66) from 1987 to 1989.

Shore duty assignments include Budget and Resources Management Officer at the Naval Aviation Schools Command in Pensacola, Florida; Acquisition/Contracting Officer at Naval Electronic Systems Command, Washington, DC; Customer Service/Outfitting Officer at the Navy Supply Center in Oakland, California; Director of the Management Center and Executive Assistant to the Chief of the Navy Supply Corps at the Naval Supply Systems Command in Washington, DC; Sea/Overseas Detailer for Supply Corps Officer personnel; Director of Systems Development and then Comptroller at the Aviation Supply Office in Philadelphia; Assistant Chief of Staff for Supply on the staff of Commander, Naval Air Force, U.S. Atlantic Fleet; Deputy Director for Material Management at the Joint Logistics Systems Center at Wright-Patterson AFB in Dayton, Ohio; Commanding Officer of the Fleet and Industrial Supply Center, Norfolk, Virginia; and Commanding Officer of Navy Exchange Service Command, Virginia Beach, Virginia. Rear Admiral Soderberg assumed his current duties as Director, Logistics/Fleet Supply Officer on the staff of the Commander in Chief, U.S. Atlantic Fleet on October 1, 1998.

His military awards include the Legion of Merit (4 awards), Meritorious Service Medal (3 awards), Navy Commendation Medal (2 awards), Navy Achievement Medal and various other campaign ribbons. He is a qualified Naval Aviation Supply Officer, Acquisition professional, and Logistics Management IT specialist.

Rear Admiral Soderberg is married to the former Jacqueline Lewis of Fargo, North Dakota. They have three children: John, Julie, and Mark.



HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

Raymond Rude is the founder and chief executive officer of Duraflex, the world's leading manufacturer of diving boards, fulcrums, stands and related equipment. During the Great Depression, he left his hometown of Stanley, N.D., and found a job shoveling sand for the Lockheed Aircraft Corporation. He quickly demonstrated his skill and potential, and worked his way up to tool engineer. In this role, he worked on the famed P-38 Lightning fighter plane. He was called on to head a team of 30 handpicked employees to tackle particularly difficult projects. His group was so successful that two more such groups were formed to work under his direction.

After World War II, Rude opened his own tool shop, fabricating parts for all major U.S. aircraft corporations. In

response to a friend's request, he fashioned a diving board from a 14-foot section of an airplane wing. It was the world's first aluminum diving board. This successful start led to the creation of the Duraflex company and the awarding of 14 patents. The design and quality of Duraflex products revolutionized the sport of diving and has made the company the dominant equipment manufacturer for more than four decades. Even with these successes, he considers his primary contributions to have been those made to the aircraft industry.

Rude continues to have strong ties to North Dakota. He is a benefactor of both the Bethel Nursing Home and the Flickertail Heritage Center in Stanley, and he contributes to UND's Center for Innovation and Tech Savvy program.

The flame

is widely recognized as a symbol of learning, lighting the path to understanding and progress. It is a symbol that has been associated with the University of North Dakota since its earliest days. One of the University's first students recalled, "That one building, standing like a wonderful beacon light on the barren prairie, was a splendid institution of higher learning in my eyes."

The Latin phrase "Lux et Lex," or "Light and Law," was adopted as the motto of the University of North Dakota in 1908 by a faculty-student committee which also created the official seal that is still in use today.

At a convocation opening the 1968-69 academic year, Dr. George Starcher, President of the University from 1954 to 1971, observed, "But the light requires law, and good law depends upon the light of truth ... The atmosphere of a university is the never-ending search for understanding, but it is also a spirit of humility which is not too sure that it is right. Have patience in the name of justice, and avoid intolerance in the name of freedom."



The "light of truth" is symbolized on the UND campus by the Old Main Memorial Sphere. Erected on the site of the University's first building, it represents the search for knowledge and the spirit of principle, responsibility and social progress. The flame also is incorporated into the University's logo, which has been in use since the celebration of the UND Centennial in 1983-1984.
