5. Ms. Lindholm reported that the Council of College Faculties met on May 7, 1998 over IVN. The CCF has asked that all of the institutional budget reduction documents be circulated among the institutions. Dr. Hillman reported to the CCF that a large portion of the 17 million dollars in projected budget cuts would stay at the Board of Higher Education level for reallocation. Some of the reallocation may be designated for another IVN line. Ms. Lindholm will place CCF updates on Factalk. Officers have been selected and that information is available on the Web.

The following are highlights of the topics reported to and discussed by the Committee during the year.

*The possible termination of the Learning After Hours Program due to declining enrollments and consideration of alternative methods of meeting these needs was discussed.

*The development and transition of the "new" Division for UND which brings together Student Affairs, Continuing Education, KUND, University Relations, Enrollment Services and Admissions will be complete July 1, 1998. Dean Robert Boyd will assume the leadership of this "new" division as Vice President and Dr. James Shaeffer will assume the position of Dean. Dr. Karen Berthold has agreed to assume the position of Assistant Dean for Continuing Education and will be responsible for extension classes, extended degree programs and correspondence study.

*The division developed four courses to be offered over the Internet. As the division proceeded with these courses, the challenges of the availability of appropriate personnel and low enrollments caused the division to step back and assess this situation. Greater conversation across the UND campus is suggested in terms of clarifying the University's position on the development and delivery of courses on the Internet.

*Fiscal Year Reports were distributed and discussed.

*Enrollments in the extended degree programs continue to increase.

*New off campus programs include the Master's of Social Work, Master's in Education - General Studies and Master's in Education - Elementary Education were initiated in Spring, 1998.

*UND's work force initiative through the Office of Work Force Development has exceeded expectations with establishment of several business partnerships and UND's success in assisting businesses that had been impacted by the flood.

*The 1997 Summer Session began on schedule and had only a slight decrease in enrollments despite the challenges raised by the 1997 flood.

*The Television Center continues to provide academic support for students through Studio One as well as video production services.

*The Division's budget reduction process to meet UND's shortfall and the requested 95% budget for FY00-01 were discussed.



Whereas the University of North Dakota has been asked to prepare a 95% budget prioritization for the 1999-2001 biennium and

Whereas the Governor of the State of North Dakota has suggested an opportunity may exist for the reallocation of resources which may be returned to the University of North Dakota and

Whereas "all legislative powers of the University government are vested in the University Council" and the University Senate acts as the agent of the Council and

Whereas the University Budget Committee is vested with authority to advise the President on budgetary matters and

Whereas recent budget reduction decisions did not include either University Senate or University Budget Committee faculty representation and

Whereas further budget deliberations may include both reduction and reallocation discussions which will directly impact faculty and the future of the academic programs at the University,

Be it resolved that faculty representatives, including the Chair and Vice Chair of the University Senate and at least one faculty representative of the University Budget Committee, selected by the Senate Executive Committee, be included in any and all future budget reduction and reallocation deliberations, including any returns of resources to the University for prioritized reallocation.
