Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of your favor of the 2nd and will do all I can to have your request complied with provided you first exhaust all means at your disposal at Beach. I suggest that you hire a couple of men and pay them at the rate of \$3.00 per day. I think I can arrange it for you if it will suit you. Let me know whether or not it would. The state paid out considerable money prosecuting John Smith and it strikes me that you certainly ought to be willing to appoint a few deputies first.
