

CHESTER FRITZ DISTINGUISHED PROFESSORS

The Chester Fritz Distinguished Professorships were established with an endowment gift from the late UND benefactor Chester Fritz, 1892-1983. Revenue from the endowment provides for cash stipends to one or more full-time UND faculty members, who thereafter may use the title "Chester Fritz Distinguished Professor." Nominations are solicited from members of the Council of Deans and the Chester Fritz Distinguished Professors; these are evaluated by a committee chaired by the graduate dean and composed of three Chester Fritz Distinguished Professors and faculty representatives from each academic college not represented by a Fritz Professor. The recommendations are reviewed by the Vice President for Academic Affairs and forwarded to the President for final decision.

Chester Fritz attended UND from 1908 to 1910. He became an international trader in precious metals and lived most of his life in China and Europe. In establishing the endowment for the professorships — just one of his many gifts to UND — as an "investment in the future of my Alma Mater and of the people who make the future what it shall be." He added, "I am especially indebted to the fine teachers who, in the end, have determined in large measure, how well I was able to learn and to use the knowledge that the University of North Dakota could provide."

2006 CHESTER FRITZ DISTINGUISHED PROFESSORS

Three University of North Dakota scholars have been awarded the Chester Fritz Distinguished Professorship, UND's highest academic accolade. Edward C. Carlson, professor of anatomy and cell biology, William D. Gosnold, Jr., professor of geology and geological engineering, and Mark R. Hoffmann, professor of chemistry, were nominated and supported for this coveted honor by their colleagues and by their academic deans. An endowment established by the late UND benefactor Chester Fritz provides for a cash stipend and a medallion to be worn on ceremonial occasions. This award recognizes "demonstrated achievement across research, teaching, and service with significant national or regional recognition in any one of these missions." The award also recognizes significant professional contributions throughout an academic career.

The first Chester Fritz Distinguished Professor was named in 1973. Just 53 individuals — including this year's selectees — have been designated Fritz Professors, 22 of whom are currently on staff.

EDWARD C. CARLSON

Edward Carlson has compiled a spectacular 25-year record as a professor and chair of the Department of Anatomy and Cell Biology in the School of Medicine and Health Sciences. Colleagues describe him as a highly effective administrator, a creative investigator, and a superb, award-winning teacher. A widely published researcher with more than 180 papers and abstracts, Carlson is known for his work in the morphometric analysis of cellular and extracellular ultrastructure, especially as applied to models of diabetic retinal and kidney ailments. He has been honored by the University and by the School of Medicine and Health Sciences for excellence in research and teaching.

A native of Michigan, Carlson received a Bachelor of Arts from Bethel College, St. Paul, Minn., with majors in biology and chemistry. He received the Ph.D. with a major in anatomy from UND in 1970. Before joining the UND faculty in 1981, he held positions with Bethel College, the University of Arizona, the University of California, Davis, and the California Primate Research Center.

WILLIAM D. GOSNOLD, JR.

Will Gosnold, a member of UND's geology and geological engineering faculty since 1982, has been that department's most prolific author, according to John Watson, dean of the School of Engineering and Mines. In his nominating letter, Watson added, "his commitment to teaching has been exemplary, and his service to the University is legion." Gosnold has published research on tectonics, petroleum formation, heat flow, gravity, geothermal energy, flood prediction/frequency, and climate change. Gosnold served as director of UND's Office of Research and Program Development (now called the Office of Research Development and Compliance) from 2001 through 2004. He has been honored by the University for excellence in research and has been very successful in getting grants to support his work.

Gosnold received a Bachelor of Arts in physics from West Georgia College in 1971 and the Ph.D. in geophysics from Southern Methodist University in 1976. Prior to joining the UND faculty, he taught at the University of Nebraska at Omaha. He has served as chair of the UND Department of Geology and Geological Engineering since 2004.

MARK R. HOFFMANN

Mark Hoffmann is, according to the letters supporting his nomination, a quintessential researcher who has "clearly contributed to advancing the Department of Chemistry at UND." The University honored the department in 1999 for overall excellence in research, and Hoffmann was presented an individual award for outstanding scientific research. Nominators described Hoffmann as a dedicated teacher, often taking on graduate students who may not be a perfect fit for the department and turning them "into scientists who go on to successful careers." Most exemplary, said Arts and Sciences Dean Martha Potvin, are Hoffmann's contributions to basic research and facilitating the research agenda at UND. Hoffmann's research group was the first to solve the "intruder state" problem in the multireference perturbation theory description of electron correlation in molecules. This seminal work has led to the application of new analytical techniques in catalysis, combustion studies, and atmospheric research. Hoffmann's research group is one of a handful globally that consistently advances hybrid perturbational-variational methods in molecular electronic structure theory.

Hoffmann received a Bachelor of Arts in anatomy and chemistry from Northwestern University in 1980 and the Ph.D. in physical chemistry from the University of California, Berkeley, in 1984. Before joining the UND faculty in 1988, he was a postdoctoral research associate at the University of Chicago and the University of Utah. He has served as chair of UND's Department of Chemistry since 2003.

Honorary Faculty Flag Marshal James Antes

The Faculty Flag Marshal at today's ceremony is Dr. James Antes, Professor of Psychology and Peace Studies. A member of the faculty since 1973, Dr. Antes was named Chester Fritz Distinguished Professor in 2004. Dr. Antes is director of the undergraduate program in the Psychology Department and enjoys helping undergraduate students identify and achieve their career goals. His special interest, and area of scholarly expertise, is social conflict and conflict resolution. He is a Fellow of the Institute for the Study of Conflict Transformation, internationally known as the leading resource on the conflict resolution process called transformative mediation.

THE 2006 COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER LANCE W. LORD

Commencement Speaker General Lance W. Lord (ret.) is former Commander of the Air Force Space Command, Peterson Air Force Base, Colorado. In that position, he was responsible for the development, acquisition, and operation of the Air Force's space and missile systems. The general oversaw a global network of satellite command and control, communications, missile warning and launch facilities, and ensured the combat readiness of America's intercontinental ballistic missile force. He led more than 39,700 space professionals who provide combat forces and capabilities to the North American Aerospace Defense Command and the U. S. Strategic Command.

General Lord entered the Air Force in 1969 as a graduate of the Otterbein College ROTC program. He completed a series of Air Staff and Department of Defense-level assignments in strategic missiles after serving four years of Minuteman II ICBM alert duty. He directed the Ground-Launched Cruise Missile Program Management Office in Europe. He was a Military Assistant to the Director of Net Assessment with the Office of the Secretary of Defense and represented the Air Force as a research associate in international security affairs at Ohio State University.



General Lord commanded two ICBM wings in Wyoming and North Dakota. In California he commanded a space wing responsible for satellite launch and ballistic missile test launch operations. He served as Director of Plans and as Vice Commander for Headquarters Air Force Space Command. The general led Air Force education and training as Commandant of Squadron Officer School, Commander of the 2nd Air Force, Commander of Air University and Director of Education for Air Education and Training Command. Prior to assuming his current position, he was the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff for Headquarters U. S. Air Force.

General Lord is a graduate of the University of North Dakota having completed a Master's Degree in Industrial Management at UND in 1972. He will also we awarded an honorary Doctor of Letters degree by UND at today's Spring Commencement ceremony.

STUDENT HONOR MEDALLIONS

Honor Medallions are worn by candidates for the bachelor's degree who achieve a scholastic average of 3.20 (cum laude), 3.50 (magna cum laude), and 3.70 (summa cum laude) in courses completed at the University of North Dakota. Also, a gold seal indicating the honor will be affixed to the diploma and the honor will be recorded on the student's academic record.

HONORARY DEGREES AWARDED

The University of North Dakota held its first commencement on June 13, 1889—the same year North Dakota became a state. Six women and two men received diplomas during a ceremony filled with oratory and reflection on the University's

Honorary degrees have long been awarded by institutions of higher learning to recognize lives of achievement. In 1909 UND presented its first honorary degree, a Doctor of Laws, to Webster Merrifield, who served the University for 25 years, including 18 as its third president.

Honorary degrees from UND particularly recognize those with an association with the University or with the state and region; they also have been presented to such notables as philosopher Mortimer Adler, heart surgeon Michael DeBakey and President John F. Kennedy.

2006 HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

A. BART HOLADAY

Growing up in Jamestown, N.D., Bart Holaday held his first job at age 10 as a prize-winning newspaper carrier for the *Minneapolis Tribune*. He graduated from the U.S. Air Force Academy in 1965 with a degree in engineering science. He then was a Rhodes Scholar at Oxford University, earning a master's degree in 1968 in politics, philosophy and economics. He graduated from George Washington University Law School in 1975 and earned CFA designation from the Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts.

The greater portion of Holaday's professional career was spent in the venture capital industry, particularly in technology areas. As managing director of Brinson Partners and UBS Asset Management, he oversaw investments of \$18 billion in venture capital, buyouts, timber, oil and gas, and real estate. Prior to his retirement in 2001, Holaday helped design and oversee the spinout of UBS Assets Management Private Markets Group into an employee-owned company, Adams Street Partners. He continues to serve on the Adams Street board of directors.

In 1991 Holaday was a founding member of the Investor's Circle, a group of socially conscious investors seeking to encourage private equity investing on the basis of social dividends as well as economic return. In 1997 Holaday and his wife Lynn founded the Dakota Foundation. Focusing on projects in his former home state of North Dakota and his current home state of New Mexico, the Foundation funds small entrepreneurial nonprofit organizations that blend financial discipline and creative thinking to address social problems. One of these projects is a University Entrepreneur Seed Fund Initiative with UND's Center for Innovation, providing college students or recent graduates with assistance in meeting startup costs for their ventures.

Holaday has been in high demand as a speaker and consultant on venture capital and social investment. He chaired a three-year industry task force that developed standardized means for valuing venture capital portfolios and reporting performance. He also was a member of a U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission advisory committee on the regulation of capital markets.

In addition to numerous other offices, Holaday has served on the boards of directors of Jamestown College, Walden University, and the UND Center for Innovation. He has funded scholarships at Jamestown College for North Dakota business students and at Exeter College, Oxford University, for outstanding graduates of the U.S. Air Force Academy.

LANCE W. LORD

Gen. Lance Lord retired in April 2006 after serving as commander of the U.S. Air Force Space Command, Peterson Air Force Base, Colorado. He was responsible for the development, acquisition and operation of Air Force space and missile systems. Gen. Lord oversaw a global network of satellite command and control, communications, missile warning and launch facilities, and ensured the combat readiness of the nation's ballistic missile force. He led nearly 40,000 space professionals who provide combat forces to the North American Aerospace Defense Command and U.S. Strategic Command.

Gen. Lord entered the Air Force in 1969 as a graduate of Otterbein College. While assigned to the Minuteman ICBM Missile Wing at the Grand Forks Air Force Base, he earned a master's degree in industrial management from UND in 1972. He has also attended the Squadron Officer School, Air Command and Staff College, Air War College, and Capstone Course, National Defense University.

Gen. Lord returned to the Grand Forks Air Force Base to command the 321st Strategic Missile Wing from February 1989 to

May 1990. He was a leader throughout his career, commanding the space wing responsible for satellite launch and ballistic missile tests, serving as commandant of the Squadron Officer School, commander of the 2nd Air Force, commander of Air University, and director of education for the Air Education and Training Command. Prior to assuming his most recent position, Gen. Lord was the assistant chief of staff for Headquarters U.S. Air Force.

In his position as commander of Space Command, Gen. Lord was instrumental in the establishment of the Space Education Consortium, a collaboration of colleges pursuing space education and research activities. The University of North Dakota is in the enviable position of being the only member of this consortium that offers a graduate degree program in space studies provided solely via distance education.

In addition to numerous decorations, Gen. Lord has been honored with the Air Force Distinguished Achievement Award, the Thomas D. White Space Trophy, and the Air Force Association's Bernard Schriever Award, James Hartinger Award, and Jimmy Doolittle Fellow Award.

RODNEY J. ROHRICH

An internationally recognized educator and physician, Dr. Rodney Rohrich is a professor and chair of the Department of Plastic Surgery, University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center, Dallas. He holds the Crystal Charity Ball Distinguished Chair in Plastic Surgery and the Betty and Warren Woodward Chair in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery.

A native of Zeeland, N.D., Rohrich graduated from North Dakota State University and then attended the UND School of Medicine, graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Medicine in 1977. He earned his M.D. from Baylor University College of Medicine. After general surgery and plastic surgery residencies at the University of Michigan Medical Center, he did further training in pediatric plastic surgery at Oxford University in England. He completed a hand and microvascular fellowship at Massachusetts General Hospital/Harvard Medical School and, in 1986, joined the Division of Plastic Surgery at UT Southwestern.

Rohrich has been the recipient of numerous prestigious national research, teaching, and service awards. An innovative educator and scientist, he holds a patent on a new breast implant and has developed educational models for bringing emerging technology to plastic surgeons. He is editor-in-chief of *Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery*, the leading journal in the field. He has also served as president of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, the largest organization of Board-certified plastic surgeons in the world

Rohrich has been a visiting professor to over 150 national and international societies and has delivered more than 1,000 scientific presentations on all aspects of plastic surgery. He has published four textbooks, more than 300 peer review articles, and 30 chapters on plastic surgery. His research interests span the entire field.

Rohrich has been included as one of The Best Doctors in America since 1996. He has been honored by both the UND and NDSU alumni associations, and as a Notable North Dakotan in 1998. In addition to his many professional activities, he is involved in civic affairs, including the American Cancer Society, the Save the Children Foundation, and arts and music organizations in Dallas.

Through his foundation, for which he serves as president, Rohrich established an endowment that provides a scholarship to a UND medical student with a rural North Dakota background and an interest in primary care.

ACADEMIC PAGEANTRY

The pageantry of American colleges and universities, including such ceremonies as commencement, has been inherited from the medieval universities of the 11th and 12th centuries. Academic life as it is known today began in the Middle Ages, first in the church and then in the guilds. The teaching guild was the Guild of the Master of Arts, in which the Bachelor was the apprentice of the Master and the dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility.

The ceremony you will witness today will be less formal than would have been the case even two decades ago. Still, many

traditions have been continued. To maintain continuity with the past, University of North Dakota faculty, the stage officials and the degree candidates will wear academic dress.

Principal features of academic garb are the gown, cap and hood. Early it became necessary for universities to set rules to preserve the dignity and meaning of academic dress. Both Cambridge and Oxford since the 15th century have made academic dress a matter of university control even to its minor details, and have repeatedly published revised regulations. American universities agreed on a definite system in 1895.

ACADEMIC DRESS

THE GOWN. The flowing gown comes from the 12th century. While it originally may have been worn as protection against the chill of unheated buildings, it has today become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any trappings of rank or social standing underneath. It is black for all degrees, with pointed sleeves for the bachelor's degree recipient, long closed sleeves with a slit at the arm or wrist for the master's degree, or full bell double sleeves for the doctoral degree. Bachelor's and master's degree gowns have no trimming. For the doctoral degree, the gown is faced down the front with velvet and has three bars of velvet across the sleeves in the color distinctive of the faculty or discipline to which the degree pertains.

THE CAP. Under Roman law, a slave that had been set free received the privilege of wearing a cap. The academic cap is a sign of freedom of scholarship, and of the responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Ancient poetry records the cap of scholarship as square to symbolize the book. The color of the tassel denotes the discipline. At the University of North Dakota, the tassel colors associated with

academic divisions are: white, College of Arts and Sciences; drab (subdued orange), College of Business and Public Administration; black and white, John D. Odegard School of Aerospace Sciences; blue and white, College of Education and Human Development; orange, School of Engineering and Mines; purple, School of Law; green, School of Medicine; apricot, College of Nursing; black, Graduate School. For undergraduate students, the tassels hang on the right side of the cap until they receive their degrees, at which time the tassel is moved to the left. For masters students, the tassel hangs on the left side of the cap and is not moved.

THE HOOD. The hood is trimmed with one or more chevrons of a secondary color on the ground of the primary color of the college. The color of the facing of the hood denotes the discipline represented by the degree; the color of the lining designates the university or college which granted the degree. The official colors of the University of North Dakota, selected by the student body in preparation for the institution's first commencement in 1889, are the pink and green of the prairie rose.

CEREMONIAL OBJECTS

THE MACE. The mace was initially modeled after a 12th-century implement of war. In earlier days, the mace, or heavy staff, was borne by or carried before a magistrate or other dignitary as an ensign of authority. A mace is placed as the symbol of royal authority on the treasury table in the British House of Commons at the opening of each session and is removed at its close. In the U.S. House of Representatives, it is a rather plain staff mounted in a marble pedestal at the right hand of the Speaker. The mace of the University of North Dakota symbolizes authority to carry out its mission, especially the granting of degrees. Made from the oak of the University's first building, "Old Main," the mace is carried by a marshal during academic processions and is placed at a prominent spot on the stage during commencement.

THE MEDALLION. A medallion or seal of office worn by the head of an educational institution is a practice that also dates to the Middle Ages. In those times, a seal was used to mark documents as official. Possession of the seal was so important

that it was usually worn around the neck for safekeeping. The wearing of the seal eventually became a symbol of authority. One side of the medallion worn by the president bears an engraving of the University's official seal and the names of all former presidents are included on the chain of office.


THE CHARTER. The University of North Dakota was founded six years before North Dakota became a state. The original, handwritten charter, enacted in 1883 by the Dakota Territorial Assembly, is preserved in UND's archives. One facsimile is displayed in the President's Office and another is used at commencements and other special occasions.

THE UNIVERSITY FLAG. The University flag features the UND flame logo set on a white background. The flag is used at ceremonial events and is carried by the honorary faculty flag marshal to lead the commencement procession. The flag is displayed on the stage during the commencement ceremony along with the mace and charter.
