Dear Sir:

Yours received in regard to gambling at Napoleon and will say that it has been practiced in the past by some of our most prominent men, but I believe, with the exception of the party referred to, that it is stopped. I have never seen any gambling myself but the system used was to move around from place to place, sometimes in cars to go out in the country and in private houses, but I believe from this on you will have no more complaint from Napoleon.
