The following announcements were made:

A. The chairperson announced that there will be no University Senate meeting in January. Mr. Grijalva announced that the Senate is waiting for an annual report from the Legislative Affairs Committee and that reports from the Academic Policies and Admissions Committee, the ROTC Committee, and the Summer Sessions Committee will be due at the February Senate meeting.

B. Mr. Grijalva announced that the Council of Deans has developed a faculty sick leave policy that will be brought to the Senate for consideration at the February meeting. He also announced that the Strategic Planning and University Planning and Budget Committees continue to meet.

- C. The chairperson reported that he had a response to a question brought up at the last Senate meeting about the status of the harassment policy. It has been sent to the U.S. Office of Civil Rights, and the University has not yet heard a response.
- D. Mr. Schuetzle announced that students interested in university governance were visiting today's meeting and welcomed them.

The Chair asked for corrections or additions to the November 4, 2004 minutes. There being none, the minutes were approved as distributed.

6.

The Chair opened the question period at 4:08 p.m.

Mr. LaDuke asked why the Senate approved candidates for degrees and what would happen if we objected. Ms. Krogh responded that it was tradition for the Senate, as the University governance body, to approve candidates for degrees even though the deans in each of the schools and colleges are responsible for certifying the completion of all requirements.

Mr. Erickson asked for more information about the sick leave policy being considered by the Dean's Council. Mr. Grijalva responded that he did not have much more information to provide.

The question period closed at 4:15 p.m.

7.

Mr. Lee moved that the annual reports of the Senate Library Committee and Senate Faculty Instructional Development Committee be received and filed. The motion was approved unanimously.

8.

Ms. Krogh moved to accept the list of candidates for degrees. The Senate discussed. The motion was approved with a vote of 55 in favor and 1 abstaining.

The report from the Senate Curriculum Committee was considered. The report was approved unanimously.

10.

The Senate considered the proposed changes to the intellectual property policy concerning copyright and intellectual property. The chair recognized Brad Myers, chair of the Intellectual Property Committee, and he gave a summary of the Committee's work and asked for questions. After discussion, the policies were approved on a vote of 54 in favor and 2 abstaining.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:20 p.m.

#### **Committee Activities**

- 0 The University Senate Library Committee met four times during 2003/04.
- 0 The Committee elected Professor Lawrence Peterson as Chair for 2003/04.
- 0 The Committee received reports on the FY2004 Library budget. The budget allowed the Library to maintain current levels of book purchases and continuation of all serial subscriptions, and to investigate acquisition of additional library resources.
- O The Director of Libraries updated the Committee on the implementation status of a new computer system to support library functions. UND libraries are members of the Online Dakota Information Network (ODIN). ODIN operates the computer system for all North Dakota University System libraries (except for the NDSU libraries) and for selected public, school, and special libraries throughout North Dakota.
- 0 The Committee discussed UND's need for scholarly information and the Library's strategies for meeting those needs through electronic resources.
- 0 Lawrence Peterson created a Senate Library Committee Web site. The Chester Fritz Library Systems Office staff will manage this Web site.

#### Selected Library Accomplishments

- 0 The Library added over 13,000 new titles to its holdings and offered access to 65 electronic databases, over 16,000 online journals, and 8,000 electronic books.
- O The Library continued to experience increases in ILL activity. Library staff requested more than 12,700 loans from other libraries and information suppliers, and responded to nearly 9,900 requests from other libraries.
- 0 From time to time the librarians of the Chester Fritz Library provide students with instruction in ways to use the Library. During the 2003/2004 year, the Library Instruction Program reached over 5,000 students.
- O The Library staff worked to convert library data and create tables for a new computer system being implemented by the Online Dakota Information Network (ODIN) libraries across North Dakota.
- 0 The Library received a grant from the Student Technology Fee Committee to upgrade the Chester Fritz Library's Instruction Room. The grant provided support for new computer workstations and presentation equipment.
- 0 Library wireless laptops and wireless cards were checked out 1,143 times, which was an increase of over 200 percent from the previous year. The service is becoming more popular each year of operation.
- O Library staff worked with librarians from South Dakota and Minnesota to solicit, evaluate, and implement a new package of electronic resources for the three-state area.

0 The Library established a supplemental reference service for American Corners and Centers libraries in the former Soviet Union. The American Corners libraries provide information about the United States to citizens in Russia and the other republics. The American Corners staff consult the Chester Fritz Library via email when they have difficult reference questions.

#### Committee Activities AY 2003-2004:

During the academic year 2003-2004, the FIDC made grant awards, funded Mini-Project Grants and Summer Instructional Development Professorships.

Forty-three proposals asking for \$32,125.26 for grants were received, compared to 73 the previous year, and 33 were funded for a total expenditure of \$19,393.38.

The Committee received ten proposals for its first offering of Mini-Project grants. Nine were funded for a total expenditure of \$11,911.81.

The committee also received 23 compared to 24 the previous year, for Summer Professorships and awarded 12 four-week and 4 two-week professorships. The total expenditure was \$44,654.45.
