

THE UND SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

The University of North Dakota School of Medicine, founded in 1905, functioned as a two-year school of basic medical science until 1973 when the state legislature approved a four-year curriculum.

The interim 2:1:1 plan, under which today's graduates have trained, provided for third-year study in Minnesota and fourth-year study in Bismarck, Minot, Grand Forks and Fargo.

The School of Medicine is in the final stage of transition to an in-state, four-year program. The third year, which has been taught in Minnesota since 1974 under the 2:1:1 plan, will be phased into an educational program utilizing academic expertise and facilities in Fargo and Bismarck.

This summer, 30 juniors will train in Fargo while 10 juniors begin a trial program in Bismarck.

By the summer of 1984, junior class sizes will level off to 20 in Bismarck and 30 in Fargo.

In its role of service to the people of North Dakota, the School of Medicine is working to realize the dictum of Senate Bill 2401, enacted March 18, 1974, which reads: "It is hereby declared to be the intent of the fortythird legislative assembly that the State of North Dakota, through its Board of Higher Education, provide for a comprehensive program of medical education leading to a doctor of medicine degree."

OATH OF HIPPOCRATES

I do solemly swear by whatever I hold most sacred, that I will be loyal to the profession of medicine and just and generous to its members.

That I will lead my life and practice my Art in uprightness and honor.

That into whatsoever home I shall enter, it shall be for the good of the sick and the well to the utmost of my power and that I will hold myself aloof from wrong and from corruption and from the tempting of others to vice.

That I will exercise my Art, solely for the cure of my patients and the prevention of disease and will give no drugs and perform no operation for a criminal purpose and far less suggest such thing.

That whatsoever I shall see or hear of the lives of people which is not fitting to be spoken, I will keep inviolably secret.

These things I do promise and in proportion as I am faithful to this oath, may happiness and good repute be ever mine, the opposite if I shall be forsworn.




