Dear Mr. Whitman:

After our telephone conversation the other day I called the Commissioner's office in an effort to find out when he would sign the order for the distribution of the segregated funds, as you requested.

I was told that the reason for the delay was that so many appeals had been filed, and that they were still awaiting settlement on some of them. Even though it has cleared the office of the solicitor, it seems that decisions have not yet been made as to some of the appeals. The office did tell me that it probably would not be long now until the order is signed and the funds distributed.

I sent you some of the bills you requested the day after I talked with you. I had to send to the Senate for the others, and just got them this morning, when I immediately mailed them to you.

If there is anything further we can do for you here please let us know.
