Dear Mr. Gross:

In the temporary absence of Senator Langer, who is in North Dakota at the present time, I am taking the liberty of giving you the information we have received in reply to the Senator's inquiry concerning the source of the appropriations for expenses of the Tribal Council.

We have been advised that the \$38,000 appropriation for use by the Tribal Council comes out of the \$400,000 tribal fund in the U. S. Treasury. Senator Langer will undoubtedly get in touch with you regarding this matter while he is in North Dakota.
