Dear Miss Stenerson:

In response to your request of September 26, addressed to Mr. Burdick at Williston, we are sending you a copy of the Congressman's brief, "Concerning the Legal Authority for the Building of the Garrison Dam at Garrison, North Dakota."

We do not have available any maps showing the lands to be flooded. However, the State Water Commission of North Dakota at Bismarck has issued a number of bulletins concerning the Garrison Dam project, and I am sure they would be glad to send you some of them.

Also, there is a booklet entitled "The Corps of Engineers in North Dakota." This is published in July, 1950, and contains some maps and descriptions and pictures of the Garrison Dam project. The office of the Army Corps of Engineers, Department of the Army, Pentagon, Washington, D. C., could probably supply you with a copy of this. It was prepared by the Missouri River Division, Fort Peck District, Upper Mississippi Valley Division, St. Paul District.

I am sorry we do not have any other available material here in the office which we can send you.
