Dear Mrs. Winge:

At times it does seem that there has not been too much support in my fight to maintain the Garrison Dam pool of 1830 feet, so you can understand that I am very much heartened by the receipt of the resolution adopted by your County's Farmers Union opposing the 1850 foot level.

It is a very well-written resolution, clearly setting forth the disadvantages of the high pool level. I am sending it immediately to the Public Works Committee in the House which is considering Mr. Lank's bill to make the 1830 foot level permanent.

I hope that the committee will give it some consideration in making their decision.
