Doar In. Socrotary:

Hiss Elisabeth Modlesky, head of the Welfare Division for Indians on the Fort Nates Reservation, was separated from the service on January 23 on charges that she was guilty of neglect of driv. She immediately, or as soon as she could, appealed her case to your consideration.

She is now fourful that the order discharging her will be confirmed without a hearing, and I carnestly suggest that she be given a hearing. I have examined a great number of affidavits, signed by other employees of the government at Fort Nates, by a number of Indians as members of the Fribal Council, and the Welfare Department of the State of North Dakota, and according to these affidavits the charges are unfounded.

If a hearing is had, she could cone forward with her proof and an ex parts approval of the removal order would be, in my opinion, a great injustice. I have no interest in her whatever, as I never not her before today, but I an always interested in doing justice to anyone.
