## PREFACE

The Summer Institute of Linguistics, University of North Dakota Branch, takes pleasure in presenting this ninth volume in the <u>Work Papers</u> series. As stated in earlier volumes, these papers are presented in pre-publication form with the hope, first, that text materials will be preserved for languages to which researchers might not otherwise have access; second, that the principles and procedures elaborated herein will prove both useful and stimulating to further thought; and third, that the resulting criticism and suggestions will lead to the improvement of subsequent manuscript drafts.
