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PREFACE

The twentieth volume of the Work Papers from the Summer Institute of Linguistics at the University of North Dakota contains research papers on Lalana Chinantec and Seri. This volume also contains a Master's thesis on copy-raising in Koiné Greek. The research papers form the first section and the thesis, which is numbered separately, forms the second section.

The first research paper explains the presence of "y" in some verbs of Lalana Chinantec of Mexico. The other two papers deal with Seri, another language found in Mexico. The first briefly examines the morphophonemics of Seri verbs, and the second discusses the use of switch-reference markers in Seri grammatical structure. The thesis deals with an often overlooked grammatical phenomenon in Koiné Greek.

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
