A BILL Jus, Jeh. 16-Granting certain grazing, fishing, and hunting rights to the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, North Dakota.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-1 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 That the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold 3 Reservation, North Dakota, and the members thereof shall 4 have the right to graze livestock on the land between the 5 actual water line of the Garrison Reservoir and the taking 6 line of such reservoir as described in part A of the joint 7 resolution entitled "Joint Resolution to vest title to certain 8 lands of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold 9 Reservation, North Dakota, in the United States, and to pro-10
