Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, Sec. 29;

All in Twp., 129 N., R. 50 W., 5th P. M.; acreage 25.46 acres

according to the Official Plat, etc.

Meanwhile I am at a loss to see where any error in legal description; and would appreciate your calling attention to the discrepancy noted; and specifically to the tract involved and how.
