that if the Garrison Dam pool level is Raised to 1840 the water level in my water Well will be 5 feet higher which will be 3 feet from the Surface and my mell is on the highest part of the farm which means that on the lower parts of the farm the water well come up to the top and so the land will Become unfit and Impossible to Culwate in other words it will be runed and at 1850 foot level with Delses and pumps we don't believe that they Dan keep the water pumped aut from Under the ground without Eventualy mining the land and besides it is cheaper to buy the project at are requested price and settle it once and for all and one other thing that I want you to know that a year ago the city of Williston money men had suposidly sent a Deligate from Lewis and Clarke Project for 1840 foot level and want you to know that he was not representing the residents

of the Lewis and Clarch Project as he was not Deligated by the Residents of the project and in fait I did not even know about it centill after it was printed in the Williston Herald it was only an Underhanded work of the few City of Williston men I believe that I made it Clear on how we the farmers stand on the Tewis and Clarch project would appriciate your helping is in the peasing the Bill and appropriating the Money to Buy the project Ikanking you in advance.
