My dear Senator:

I have made arrangements with the Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of Fort Berthold Reservation to hold council at Elbowoods with the members of the Business Council and such other members of the Three Tribes as may wish to attend.

I will arrive at Elbowoods, May 23rd, late in the day. I have asked the Council to meet in continuous session May 24th to 31st inclusive. The purpose of the council is to discuss the Garrison Dam matter in all its aspects.

If I do not meet you while I am in the State, I will call and report to you on the results of the council on my return to Washington.
