The following announcements were made:

- A. Mr. Rice informed the Senate that he referred the proposed State Board of Higher Education policy changes to three University Senate committees. These committees were charged to report with specific recommendations at a special meeting of the Senate on January 13, 2000:

Standing Committee on Faculty rights:

- Policy 605.1 Academic Freedom and Tenure
- Policy 605.2 Standing Committee on Faculty Rights
- Policy 605.3 Non-renewal, Termination and Dismissal
- Policy 605.4 Hearings and Appeals
- Policy 612 Faculty Grievances

Legislative Affairs:

- Policy 305.1 Presidential Authority

Compensation:

- Policy 607.4 Sick Leave

- B. Mr. Rice also announced that he is calling a meeting of the University Senate on January 13, 2000 to receive the recommendations of the three committees in time to allow the Senate to make recommendations before the BHE meeting on January 20, 2000.

- C. Ms. Shabb, Chair of the Committee on Committees, announced that Nancy Vogeltanz-Holm was appointed to the Student Academic Standards Committee for one year to replace Fred Schneider. Ms. Shabb also informed the Senate that there is a vacancy on the Student Policy Committee. If anyone is interested in that position, he/she should contact her or other members of the Committee on Committees.

- D. A Senate Web page was formed by the Registrar's Office. The address for the site is www.und.edu/dept/AdmisInfo/oar/senind.html. Included on the site are the following: the Bylaws of the University ^{Senate} System; the University of North Dakota Constitution; and the Standing Rules of the University Senate. The University Senate Committee Manual is in the process of being added to the site.

- E. Mr. Bridewell informed the Senate that implementation of a Senate list serve conflicts with the North Dakota Open Meetings laws. Since there would be no notice to the public of the discussions taking place, no visitors could participate in the meetings. Mr. Bridewell will investigate other options and report back to the Senate at a later date.

5.

Ms. DeMers moved to approve the minutes from the November 4, 1999 meeting. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried unanimously.

6.

The Chair announced the Question Period. Mr. Lowe read a statement asking Mr. Kupchella to convene the University Council to develop a process to retire the Fighting Sioux nickname and logo and to develop a new nickname and logo (Attachment #1). Mr. Kupchella agreed to call the meeting and set the agenda to include this issue. Mr. Kupchella spoke at some length about recent events having to do with the introduction of a new logo.

7.

Ms. Williams moved that the tentative list of candidates for degrees in December 1999, be approved for recommendation to the State Board of Higher Education for the awarding of degrees indicated, upon satisfactory completion of the work of the present semester. Mr. Munski seconded the motion, which was voted upon and carried unanimously. (Attachment #2)

8.

Ms. Norman moved to accept the recommendations from the Curriculum Committee regarding New Programs, Change of Titles, Program Changes (Admission Standards), New Courses, and Course Deletions. Ms. Cutler seconded the motion. Discussion commenced. (Attachment #3)

Mr. Marshall moved to divide the B.B.A. with major in Entrepreneurship from the motion. The motion was seconded, voted upon and approved. Mr. Marshall moved to delay the vote on the new program until after the Senate heard the report from the Provost regarding the Strategic Investment Pool and the Academic Program Investment Pool. The motion was seconded, voted upon and approved.

The main motion as divided, to accept the recommendations from the Curriculum Committee for Change of Titles, Program Changes (Admission Standards), New Courses, and Course Deletions was voted upon and carried unanimously.

9.

Sara Hanhan reported from the Provost regarding the Academic Program Investment Pool. Discussion commenced regarding the guidelines detailing which programs are eligible to apply for a portion of the funds. Mr. Kupchella said he would confer with the Provost to answer the questions. Mr. Marshall moved to postpone the report until the next meeting. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried unanimously.

10.

Mr. Bridewell moved to extend the meeting for an additional 20 minutes. The motion was seconded, voted upon and approved unanimously.

11.

The main motion to accept the recommendation of the University Curriculum Committee in regard to the approval of the B.B.A. with major in Entrepreneurship request for new program was voted upon and approved by a vote of 42 for, 0 against, and 12 abstaining.

12.

Ms. Shabb, Chair of the Committee on Committees, named Mr. Bridewell as the Committees' nomination to replace Mr. Rice as Senate Chair. The Chair called for additional nominations from the floor. Ms. Gabrynowicz moved nominations cease and a unanimous ballot be cast for Mr. Bridewell. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried unanimously.

13.

Ms. Shabb, Chair of the Committee on Committees, presented the nominees for Vice Chair to replace Mr. Bridewell: David Perry and Monte Phillips. The Chair called for additional nominations from the floor; there were none. The Senate voted and Mr. Perry was elected Vice Chair.

14.

Ms. Shabb, Chair of the Committee on Committees, named Ms. Gabrynowicz to complete Mr. Rice's three-year term on the Council of College Faculties. The Chair called for additional nominations from the floor. Mr. Antes moved nominations cease and a unanimous ballot be cast for Ms. Gabrynowicz. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried unanimously.

Request to Convene the University Council

The past several days have demonstrated to all of us the depth of feeling associated with our athletic team nickname and various logos. None of this controversy is new. In 1972, all North Dakota universities were directed by the State Board of Higher Education to examine and make appropriate changes to Native American nicknames; the issue has been studied extensively in the intervening 28 years.

What is most striking about recent events is the anger being directed against Native American students, who--regardless of their stand on the nickname or logo--have been targeted as "the enemy" by other members of our university community. The result can be seen in the disrupted lives of our Native American students, who are struggling to finish the semester in an atmosphere that can best be described as hostile. It is clear to many of us that this kind of hostile atmosphere will continue to flare up at intervals, so long as we persist in using Native Peoples as team mascots. All of us--administrators, teachers, staff, and students--have a binding responsibility to provide a safe and respectful educational environment for every member of the UND community.

With this in mind, president Kupchella, I ask you to convene a meeting of the University Council, with the clear objective of developing a process by which the University of North Dakota can respectfully and gracefully retire the Fighting Sioux nickname and Indian Head logo, replacing them with a logo and nickname that will bring honor and pride to *all* North Dakotans. President Kupchella, will you convene the Council?
