The enclosed letter shoring the troubles that farmers outside of the Fort Berthold Reservation are having with horses owned by the Indians of the reservation is certainly self-explanatory.

If you have not already done so, I hope that you will give some consideration to the problem immediately, looking either to the disposal of the horses or their containment behind the reservation fence.

I would think that this is a matter that could be salved satisfactorily within the present authority of your department, but if there should be anything required in a legislative may. I would be anxious to do what I can to assist you. This is a serious problem to these people and must be taken care of.
