Dear Mr. Rustad:

This will admowledge receipt of your letter telling of your difficulties with the reservation horses.

You certainly do have a problem and I hope we can do scretning to help you solve it. I am writing immediately to the Bureau of Indian Affides and to the Superintendent of the reservation at Elbowoods, asking them to take immediate steps to either dispose of their horses or keep them within the boundaries of the reservation.

As soon as I hear from those people, I will write you again. Further, I hope to be able to contact Carl Whitmen, Charman of the Tribal Business Council, who, I believe, is still in Washington, and discuss the matter with him.

You can be sure I will keep after this matter until some solution is reached.

Will you please convey this message to Mr. Matteen and Mr. Giffey, who also signed your letter. Donnell Haugen sends his greetings.
