The following announcements were made:

- Ms. Weaver-Hightower acknowledged and thanked all those who supported the University Senate this year.

- President Schafer and incoming President Kennedy thanked Ms. Weaver-Hightower for her work as Chair of Senate and presented her an appreciation plaque.
- Ms. Weaver-Hightower recognized and thanked all of the Senators whose terms were up. She thanked the members of the Senate Executive Committee for their service, and also thanked Lori Hofland and Marci Mack for their ongoing support of University Senate. Ms. Gjellstad presented both with a plant.
- President Schafer was thanked for all of his support of University Senate.
- President Kennedy thanked all involved on University Senate. He stated that he looks forward to his start in July.
- Ms. Weaver-Hightower welcomed Student Body President, Brandon Beyer, and Student Body Vice President, Blake Andert, stating that we look forward to working with them in the future.
- Ms. Weaver-Hightower reviewed the list of priorities from the beginning of the year, which included: climate, morale, bullying/civility, communications, shared governance, faculty governance, research support, budget, administration evaluations, promotion and tenure guidelines, master planning, and library support. She stated that University Senate has made progress on these priorities throughout the year and accomplished much.
- Ms. Weaver-Hightower announced that, after the meeting, a party will be held at the Stone House to celebrate all of the hard work done by Senate this year.
- It was announced that the results of the Senate Committee elections will be posted to the Senate webpage soon.

- Ms. Henderson reported on the Employee Engagement Survey. Overall participation was 32%. The number of responses vs. the number invited to respond were as follows:
  - Faculty-110/276 (40%)
  - Adjunct-5/24 (21%)
  - Administration-43/96 (45%)
  - Exempt-80/259 (31%)
  - Non-Exempt-81/345 (23%)
 The results of the survey will be available in late July or early August.
- The *Code of Student Life* policies may be reviewed and commented on by going directly to the New & Revised Policy Updates website. The proposed changes include: revising the student conduct suspension process; reducing duplication within the *Code*; increasing the level of clarity within the document; and reviewing and updating policies and procedures as they relate to responding to issues of sexual misconduct and harassment. This document has not yet been reviewed by the

Policy Advisory Group. It was developed by the *Code of Student Life* Review Committee. Contact the Dean of Students Office, 777-2664, if you have questions.

- An update on the Qualified Faculty Requirements (QFR) Committee was given by Eric Wolfe. He gave a brief overview of the Committee and reported that HLC has new requirements that need to be in place by fall 2017. Representatives from all schools and colleges at UND provided their input.
- Mr. Quinn reported on the Ad Hoc Student Evaluation of Teaching Implementation Committee (SETIC). He gave a brief overview on the Committee's work and on the new instrument that they will be implementing. Mr. Quinn thanked the Committee for all of their hard work. He stated that they have finished the pilot program and will partially roll out a new instrument in the fall and, hopefully, the full instrument in the spring. It will be online only. This instrument can be customized by faculty/departments. It will be integrated with PeopleSoft and Blackboard. This instrument can be used to assist with data analysis for future predictions. There is a power point available for everyone to preview. If you have questions, please contact Mr. Quinn.
- A report on the Ad Hoc Committee for the Study of Practices for the Evaluation of Administration (SPEA) was given by Ms. Hunter. She gave a brief update on this Committee's work and reported that best practices across the nation of administrative evaluations and review were looked at. UND's policy on evaluation was reviewed. The recommendation was to have a permanent committee to work on this issue.
- College representatives reported on budget discussions from each of the colleges.
- Ms. Christopherson gave a brief report on the Council of College Faculties.
- Ms. Weaver-Hightower reported on planned Senate Executive Committee (SEC) summer work. Senators were invited to join SEC meetings over the summer. The work of the SEC will include:
  - Plans for communication between Senate and administration and between Senators and constituents;
  - Work on the structure of the University Senate
  - Work on Faculty governance/Faculty Senate;
  - Discussion of student member attendance (rethink number of students, increase attendance);
  - Discussion of staff representation;
  - Work on the structure of University Senate to further collaboration between faculty, staff, and students;
  - Work to increase engagement of the President, Provost, VP's;
  - Work on documents to be brought to the Senate, e.g., draft Senator job descriptions, work on the Faculty Handbook and web page, work on language to help committees revise charges, revise the Committee Manual, and research "No Confidence" procedures;
  - Analysis of areas for revision to University Senate bylaws;
  - Continuation of work from this year, e.g., continue work on anti-bullying and morale, look at number of tenure track lines vs. contingent faculty, increase faculty involvement in Master Planning, and gather campus priorities;
- A transition program for employees being cut due to the budget process was announced. The program can be accessed at:

The minutes of the previous meeting were presented. A motion was made by Mr. Gedafa to accept the minutes as presented. Ms. Christopherson seconded and the minutes were approved as distributed.

6.

The question period was opened at 4:52 p.m.

Ms. Rakow made a motion to add discussion of a faculty assembly to the business calendar. Mr. Sheridan seconded and the item was added to the business calendar.

Ms. Laguette asked if there was any way to get money to help assist with the promotion process. Ms. Brekke spoke to this issue. In this budget cycle, it was stated that the dollars available were not to exceed 3% of occupied positions. The promotions piece during the annual process becomes part of that 3%, so there are no additional funds available for the promotion process.

Ms. Juntunen asked Ms. Brekke to qualify the 3% ceiling. Ms. Brekke replied that it is an average, it is not the maximum on the salary range, i.e., someone can get 5% and someone can get 0% if they don't meet expectations on their annual review. This cycle is different than the past cycles and raises.

Ms. Rakow asked about the questions that were presented at the last meeting and if answers could be given. She stated that the campus has not been adequately informed on these issues. Ms. Weaver-Hightower responded that she is working on finding answers to the questions.

President Schafer gave a statement regarding the budget cuts from day one and reported that a summary of the cuts is posted on the web page.

Ms. Weaver-Hightower stated that this is not going to be the first time for budget cuts and that the Senate needs to look at mechanisms to help with the next budget cuts.

President Schafer stated that we should be examining the content of budget workshops to see if they can be expanded to contain the new steps and also the future MIRA budget so that people can understand the process.

Ms. Hunter recognized Marcia Mikulak. Ms. Mikulak asked why certain colleges were cut more than other colleges, e.g., why was the College of Arts and Sciences cut more than any other college. Dean Storrs made a comment regarding this question. The actual percent was 7.8%, which is less than other colleges that had up to 10% cuts. There was much discussion at each department within the College regarding these cuts and everyone had a say. Decisions were difficult to make but were necessary.

Ms. Kenville moved to extend the question period for five minutes provided a new question was asked. Mr. Quinn seconded the motion. The motion failed.

The question period closed at 5:17 p.m.

7.

Mr. Munski moved to accept in toto the following annual reports: Senate Budget, Restructuring and Reallocation Committee, Senate Honorary Degrees Committee, Senate Standing Committee on Faculty Rights, Senate Scholarly Activities Committee, Senate Online and Distance Education Committee, University Curriculum Committee, and the Senate Compensation Committee. Mr. Quinn seconded, and the reports were accepted and filed.

8.

The candidates for degrees in May, 2016, were presented. Ms. Kenville moved to accept, Ms. Henderson seconded, and the motion carried.

9.

The University Curriculum Committee report was presented. A motion was made by Mr. Sheridan and seconded by Mr. Munski to accept the report. The motion was approved.

10.

Proposed changes to the Senate Online and Distance Education Committee charge were presented. A motion was made by Mr. Quinn to accept the changes. Ms. Laguette seconded the motion, and the motion was approved.

11.

Ms. Rakow moved to extend the meeting by ten minutes. Mr. Gedafa seconded and the motion carried.

12.

Ms. Rakow moved to create an ad hoc committee of the University Senate called the Faculty Assembly. Mr. Sheridan seconded the motion. Discussion followed. Ms. Weaver-Hightower asked if it was to be an actual Senate committee or a group that gathers to discuss issues. Ms. Rakow stated that this group met all of the criteria to be a Senate committee. Ms. Laguette asked who would be on the Committee. Ms. Rakow said that all tenured faculty would be members of the Committee and that 10% of the membership would be needed to constitute a quorum. Ms. Kenville made a motion to close the discussion. Mr. Martin seconded and the motion carried. The motion to create an ad hoc committee called "the Faculty Assembly" failed.

## 2015-16 Senate Budget, Restructuring and Reallocation Committee

## Annual Report

The 2015-16 University Senate Budget, Restructuring and Reallocation Committee has met frequently during the year, with the pace of meetings accelerating during the spring. Although the committee had originally identified the continued migration to the MIRA budget model as its priority for the year, that goal was quickly replaced with concerns regarding changes to the University's budget necessitated by the 2015 legislative session, the allotment cuts ordered by the Governor, and the decision by president Schafer to forgo the 2.5% tuition increase authorized by the state board of higher education.

Specific actions the committee has undertaken and/or completed are:

- ❖ Integration of new membership to the committee. Last year the membership of the committee was increased to ensure representation from all the academic colleges, along with staff and students, as well as liaison membership with other senate committees with particular interest in the implementation of MIRA.
- ❖ Meeting with MIRA implementation leads, and Finance and Operations staff to discuss the status of the new budget model implementation, tuition model changes, & governance in the new budget model, and continued involvement in the presentation of Budget 102 & 103 presentations.
- ❖ Meeting with Provost concerning the changes made to the University Budget because of the shortfall in the 2016 fiscal year because of the difference between the tuition increase used to construct the budget and the maximum tuition increase approved by the legislature.
- ❖ Meeting with the Provost concerning the changes to be made to the 2017 fiscal year budget because of the tuition shortfall, the allotment cut ordered by the governor and President Schafer's decision to forgo any tuition increase for the year.

There are three concerns that have emerged that must be addressed in order for the new budget model to be effective.

1. Despite public assertions made during the last year, it appears the significant planning, priority setting and decision making is being done without faculty, staff or student input (e.g., the decision to eliminate the position of graduate dean). Budget decisions can only be made in the context of clearly articulated university priorities, which must be publicly agreed upon by all stake holders.
2. Last year the committee expressed the need for consistent, frequent, and timely communication on budget matters. Specifically, the committee asked that the following information be available: "assumptions that undergird the budget process, dissemination in writing of policies and procedures [faculty receive word that a decision was made because of a policy but the policy is not available], the rationale for rules and rule changes, and budget decisions. The current year, however, does not indicate that the administration has taken this request

seriously. Despite frequent, direct requests for more information, the committee has consistently been placed in the position of responding to decisions that have already been made.

3. Under MIRA, significant budgetary decisions will be made at the college and other operating unit level. If the faculty, staff and students only have input at the vice-president level, the ability of faculty to shape future budget decisions will be diminished. The future of faculty participation in the budget process must ensure a faculty role at the college, vice-president and presidential levels. It is the hope of the committee that each college and other operating unit will develop budget committees or other similar mechanism for developing their budgets that can liaise with the committee.

The committee continues to see its role in the budget redesign process and the continuing budget creation process:

- ❖ to **educate** faculty, staff and students on the university budget and how the budget impacts the university mission and strategic priorities.
- ❖ to **advocate** for faculty, staff and student voices in budget planning and decision-making.
- ❖ to **advocate** on the behalf of faculty, staff and student interests in the university planning and budget decision-making processes.
- ❖ to **understand** and **inform** the administration on the impact the budget has on the on operation of the university and the fulfillment of its mission.



**Senate Honorary Degrees Committee  
Annual Report for  
Academic Year 2014-2015**

The purpose of the Senate Honorary Degrees Committee is to provide a vehicle for granting honorary degrees according to the current university standards and policies. Membership of the committee is made up of five faculty (each from a different college), the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies, and the Vice President for Academic Affairs (or a designee). Faculty serve five year terms. The Dean of the School of Graduate Studies and the Vice President for Academic Affairs (or a designee) each serve a term that is concurrent with the office.

The Senate Honorary Degrees Committee for the 2014-2015 academic year was chaired by Kim Kenville (JDO). Thomasine Heitkamp (from the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs) served as the committee facilitator. Committee members for the 2014-2015 year included:

Functions and Responsibilities of the Honorary Degrees Committee

The University Senate has identified four areas of responsibility for the Honorary Degrees Committee. The responsibilities of the Committee and its accomplishments during the 2014-2015 academic year are addressed as follows:

1. **Solicit nominations for honorary degrees.**  
The call for nominations for honorary degrees was posted in the University Letter on December 1, 2014. The call was also posted on the VPAA's web site. The deadline to submit nominations was January 16, 2015.
2. **Establish a procedure for reviewing nominations and making a recommendation.**  
Thomasine Heitkamp facilitated the process for reviewing nominations. All application materials were posted to a Blackboard site that was accessible only by members of the Honorary Degrees committee. The committee met on January 22, 2015 to discuss the nominations and to make a recommendation.
3. **Consider nominations and submit a recommendation to the University Senate.**  
Seven nominations were received and reviewed by the Honorary Degrees Committee. After discussion at the January 22, 2015 meeting, it was decided to recommend four names to the University Senate for honorary degrees. Kim Kenville presented the four nominees to the Senate on February 4, 2015. All four recommendations were voted on and accepted by the Senate.
4. **Review current university policies, standards, and procedures for granting an honorary degree and submit recommendations to the Senate.**  
Prior to the January 22, 2015 meeting, Thomasine Heitkamp circulated reminders of the functions and responsibilities of the Committee, the State Board of Higher Education (SBHE) policies and UND standards/procedures that guided the work of the Honorary Degrees Committee. These are published in the SBHE Policies, Section 430.1 Honorary Degrees; and the University of North Dakota (UND) University Senate Committee Manual (Honorary Degrees, pp. 25-26). The committee discussed the policies, standard and procedures; no changes were recommended to the Senate.

**Summary:** During 2014-2015, the Honorary Degrees Committee fulfilled its purpose, function and responsibilities including soliciting nominations for honorary degrees, establishing a procedure for reviewing nominations and making a recommendation, considering nominations and submitting a recommendation to the University Senate, and reviewing current policies and procedures related to the charge of the committee.

During the academic year of 2015-2016, the Standing Committee on Faculty Rights (hereafter SCoFR) heard and completed one formal hearing. Although this hearing was initiated at the end of Dr. Poochigian's term as chair, the committee determined that the hearing would be chaired by the incoming chair, Dr. Murphy. At the conclusion of the Hearing, recommendations were forwarded to the President who made the final decision.

Up to this date, no requests have been made to the committee regarding any potential proceedings in the summer of 2016. However, as we near the end of the semester, such requests may be made.

SCoFR will meet in May to finalize changes on the changes to the UND policy and procedures for 605 grievances. This will be forwarded to the chair of the University Senate to consider at the September or October meetings as time permits.

In addition, the committee commented to the chair of the University Senate regarding the wording in the Faculty Handbook regarding 605 grievances relative to the processes used for faculty under a special appointment.

**Senate Scholarly Activities Committee**

The Senate Scholarly Activities Committee has met 6 times during the 2015-2016 academic year. As it has in past years, SSAC awarded faculty Travel, Research/Creative Activity, and Publication grants, and New Faculty Scholar Awards. In addition, SSAC reviewed applications for the new Early Career Awards and ranked those applications. SSAC then forwarded those rankings to the Vice President for Research & Economic Development. SSAC has one more meeting scheduled for May 2, at which we will award the final round of Travel grants for this fiscal year and elect officers for next academic year.

The SSAC received fewer applications for the New Faculty Scholar Award this year than it has in past years (one application in 2016, compared with four applications each year in the previous three years). We believe that this reduced interest in the NFS was due primarily to the creation of separate Early Career Awards, with more generous funding guidelines and similar application deadlines. The maximum NFS Award is \$5,000, and only faculty who have completed less than three years at UND are eligible. SSAC funds are consistently insufficient to meet applicant demand overall, and until this year the NFS was no exception. Following precedent of past years, the committee decided at our September 14 meeting to allocate 20% of our budget toward the NFS, for a total of only \$12,292.81 (less than three awards at the \$5,000 level). In contrast, the new Early Career Awards were potentially far more lucrative – with a maximum award of \$20,000, and a total budget of up to \$100,000. Applications for the ECA were less restrictive than NFS, being open to all pre-tenure tenure-track faculty, and also carried fewer restrictions on how award dollars could be spent. It is therefore not surprising that the Early Career Award program received far more applications – 21 in all – than did the NFS.

SSAC was glad to see additional funding made available for early career faculty, and we hope that the University will continue to support our newer colleagues. However, the committee was frustrated with several aspects of the experimental Early Career Award this year, and hopes that changes can be made in future years to award these funds more effectively:

1. The Early Career and New Faculty Scholar awards should either be combined or more carefully distinguished to ensure that they are supporting early career faculty as effectively as possible.
2. Should the Early Career and New Faculty Scholar Awards continue to be awarded separately, then it should be made clear whether faculty can apply for and hold both awards simultaneously. If the same individual can receive both awards, care should be taken to ensure that they are not receiving funding from both sources for the same materials or labor.
3. Funding priorities and application guidelines for the Early Career Award were frustratingly vague. The SSAC has worked for many years to refine its application and review processes. We would urge that the Early Career Award and any other new grants intended to support

research/creative activity would adopt or adapt the guidelines that have been refined by SSAC or by other existing committees, such as the Seed Money grants.

4. Given the larger budgets and larger number of applications involved, the Early Career Award committee should be larger than the current SSAC to incorporate expertise from all areas of research/creative activity represented in the applicant pool.

Again, SSAC is glad to see new funding opportunities for early career faculty. We urge that steps be taken to solidify the standing of the Early Career Award in the future.

In addition to its usual work awarding SSAC-sponsored funding (New Faculty Scholar Awards and Research/Creative Activity, Publication and Travel grants) and assisting with awarding the newly created Early Career Award, this year SSAC also worked to document the long-term impact of its very limited funding. The Chair of SSAC worked closely with the Chair of the University Senate to conduct a qualitative survey that was distributed to all 112 recipients of SSAC funding from 2014-2015. Twenty-five respondents from twenty departments across campus chose to participate, providing concrete evidence of the value of continued SSAC funding, and testifying to the need for expanded funding. We encourage your attention to the report resulting from this study, which we have attached to as an addendum to this annual report.

In closing, SSAC wishes to emphasize the important work that is supported by our very limited budget. Although total numbers are not yet available for this fiscal year, demand for SSAC awards remains high. Travel grants are in particularly high demand. Although SSAC budgeted 60% of its \$57,000 budget to travel grants, those funds consistently fell far short of demand:

9/21/15 meeting: Travel Awards: 54 applications totaling \$67,159.67. \$11,443.40 (17.0% of total requested) was divided among 44 faculty members. Award amounts ranged from \$134.41 to \$739.19.

1/25/16 meeting: Travel Awards: 34 applications totaling \$41,717.19. \$12,216.75 (29.2% of total requested) was divided among 33 faculty members. Award amounts ranged from \$173.60 to \$749.95.

Need for travel funds will undoubtedly increase in the next fiscal year, as departmental travel budgets have been greatly reduced. Indeed, current budget proposals include eliminating travel funds within many units. While we recognize that the University is in the midst of a budget crisis, we would urge continued – and indeed increased – funding for these crucial programs.

### ***Committee Recommendations:***

- We strongly urge the university administration to utilize this committee as a resource in developing plans that help the institution meet necessary budget targets while supporting student success and retention in the online and distance degree environments. Distance degree programs and online courses reduce costs for facilities, yet require thoughtfully-planned supports to ensure equivalent student learning and retention. The most significant enrollment growths of the past decade at UND have been the result of new distance degree programs that serve our rural state, the region, and beyond.
- Additionally, we urge the university administration to incorporate data about online and distance degree programs into strategic plans for enrollment growth. While online classes and distance degree programs do not add significantly to campus space needs, online teaching requires additional resources, services, and supports. PAR data clearly demonstrate that this area requires significant attention given problems with student retention. Alignment of online and distance education with the university's strategic planning processes is also required by the upcoming HLC assessment.
- This committee will continue to partner with administration and campus stakeholders to actively tying PAR and Starfish data to interventions that increase student retention and success in the online and distance environments.

## ***Summary of Committee Activities for AY 2015-2016***

The Senate Distance and Online Education Committee met seven times during AY 2015-2016. Early in the academic year, the Senate Executive Committee requested that we review and update the committee charge to ensure consistency with other Senate committees. This charge was approved October 26, 2015. To reflect better planning for leadership succession, a vice chair (Jeff Holm) was elected with the understanding that this office is in preparation for the chair role the following academic year. To complete succession planning congruent with the model used by the Senate Executive Committee, a new charge providing a one-year seat for the immediate past chair was passed at the final meeting on April 25, and Jeff Holm was confirmed as the chair for the upcoming year. Committee members also wish to express their appreciation for allowing for the natural expiration of terms for members appointed under the previous Senate-approved charge. With the election of new individuals and the support of the Committee on Committees, SODEC will begin the next academic year with representation from each college for the first time.

Utilizing some themes from our final meeting the previous academic year, the committee set several priorities for the year, which included the following:

- Look for opportunities to support institutional strategic planning around enrollment growth in relation to distance degrees and online courses (with accompanying analysis of structure and budget needed to support identified targets).
- Provide input on decisions related to tuition models and fees.
- Bring together relevant institutional data and help build campus awareness about how to capture and use PAR data to better support students in the online environment.
- Improve committee's capacity to be a resource to faculty.
- Identify ways to improve the student experience in the distance degree and online environment.

Given the uncertain budget environment coupled with the move to MIRA, committee members focused efforts this year on the latter three priorities. Justin Fraase, Office of Extended Learning staff, generously lent his expertise to helping the committee develop a user-friendly and interactive committee webpage that will be linked to the Senate Committee webpage's site. As of this writing, the template has been reviewed and refined by committee members at several meetings. Work over the summer can continue to populate the new website with the next academic year's committee members and to add additional content. The new website will help the committee raise campus awareness of SODEC as a faculty resource, and will help make the campus community more aware of our mission and charge.

The committee reviewed PAR data showing that certain categories of undergraduate online students are substantially more at risk of withdrawing from their studies. UND data from 2009 to 2013 indicated that 48% of undergraduate students enrolled exclusively in online courses would not return the next year compared to 26% of students enrolled solely in campus-based course. Top risk factors for withdrawal for these students broke down as follows:

- Students with 6 or more credits online
- Students over the age of 24
- Students who didn't obtain a cumulative C GPA in at least 6 credits
- Students who didn't complete at least 50% of their attempted credits
- Students who had a start date than the beginning of Fall Semester

Committee members also looked at Starfish as a means for improving supports for students in the online environment. While Starfish shows promise as a system to provide early warnings and to support early intervention efforts with struggling students, significant barriers to its use persist, including lack of Blackboard use or inconsistent use of the gradebook feature, as well as a lack of awareness by faculty about Starfish or its potential value to students. Committee members expressed interest in seeing if there are ways that Starfish data can be broken out for online courses and analyzed separately from traditional campus classes.

To better acquaint the campus community with PAR and Starfish in relation to the distance and online environments, SODEC co-sponsored a Spring forum on February 17. Fifty-two individuals were in attendance, and comments were positive, with participants wanting more in-depth information through additional workshops and seminars. Many forum participants said they were hearing about these tools for the first time, and finding ways to support the campus community to connect with these data and tools will likely be a continuing objective for next year's committee as members have generated a number of good ideas to test.

At the request of the Senate Executive Committee, the Office of Extended Learning (OEL) provided an update on enroll anytime courses (see written report attached). Currently 80% of the students are non degree-seeking. The average age of the students is 27, and most are taking the enroll anytime courses to fill a schedule gap. OEL staff are continuing to systematically meet with each department chair and college dean; it is these individuals who approve the faculty teaching these courses.

Committee members discussed ways to improve the student connections to UND and its campus.. Joan Hawthorne offered to spearhead the effort; plans for focus groups are proceeding over the next several weeks with support from our graduate student representative. Committee members discussed ways to improve the graduation



experience for distance degree students. Beginning with this Spring's graduation activities, a letter will be sent asking distance degree students if they would like their names read at commencement; they will also be given an option to provide a photo.

In relation to upcoming HLC assessment, online and distance degree programs will be tasked to ensure equivalence in terms of student learning, regardless of the class format. Planning in relation to online and distance education needs to align with the institution's strategic plan.

**Summary of Activities of the Committee:**

1. Address general curriculum issues of interest to the university
  - Addressed the issue of Cross-listing courses and supported the approval of encouraging this method of course offerings for the future.
  
2. Establish guidelines and procedures for course/program changes including new courses and programs
  - Integration of new membership to the committee to include a 2<sup>nd</sup> representative from the College of Arts and Sciences (one from each area).

## University Curriculum Committee Annual Report 2015-2016

- Efforts were made to improve communication and enhance the understanding of the review process of course/program changes at the department and college level.
    - Department chairs and college curriculum committee chairs were provided with guidelines regarding the review process in the fall and UCC members were in contact with their respective college curriculum representatives to assist as needed.
    - Recommended change to the UCC membership to include “that UCC members shall be a sitting or ex-officio member of their college/school curriculum committee and include the Director of Essential Studies or designee as an ex-officio member”.
  - Close coordination and communication with Office of Provost & Vice President for Academic Affairs, Office of Registrar to streamline process and speed communication about course/program changes.
  - Revisions were made to the UCC website and the CourseLeaf site to be more informative and user friendly.
  - Departments/program faculty were informed by the UCC representative of all course/program approvals following each UCC meeting.
  - Presentation was given to the UCC by the MIRA implementation lead staff from Finance & Operations and discussion held on the new budget model and how the UCC work will be impacted.
    - Recommend changes to the function and responsibilities of UCC to include two additional functions, “Ensures that proposed changes maintain academic integrity and adhere to sound educational practices” and “Collaborate to ensure curricular changes align with university priorities and sound resource allocation decisions”.
  - UCC will be hosting an end of the year campus-wide meeting with department/college curriculum committee faculty leads to facilitate communication and improved processes for the future.
3. Consider and approve requests for course/program changes and proposals for new courses/programs and forward recommendations to the Senate.
- UCC reviewed and acted upon the following undergraduate, graduate, and program proposals:
    - Program Terminations - 5
    - New Academic Programs - 6
    - Department Title Changes - 6
    - New Courses - 134
    - Course Changes - 280
    - Course Deletions - 81

4. Ensure a University-wide curricular perspective.
  - UCC members reviewed all course/program requests with an eye for campus duplication, appropriate pedagogy and appropriate budgetary support from the college.
    - Recommend change to this function and responsibilities of UCC to include a statement “promoting the development of interdisciplinary course and programs”.
5. Elected Sima Noghianian (CEM) as UCC Chair for 2016-2017.
6. Recommendations for next academic year:
  - Continued efforts to communicate with and help educate faculty, chairs, and program directors on the curriculum approval process and the responsibilities of the department and college in the process.
  - Continued and enhanced communication and coordination with the VPAA Office and Registrar’s Office to streamline process, provide timely and informed solutions to curricular issues.
  - Clarification and ongoing consideration of roles and responsibilities of UCC members in facilitating outreach, communication, and coordination with faculty, chairs, program directors, and college committees.
  - Create broadened opportunities for meaningful discussion of university-wide curricular issues and best practices regarding such issues as course credit for Undergraduate Teaching Assistants and tutoring/peer mentoring.
  - Collaboration with other committees and units to develop and codify understanding of appropriate role for UCC in facilitating successful implementation of MIRA.

 Vice-Provost (non-voting)

 Office of Extended Learning (one, voting)  
 Center for Instructional Learning and Technologies (one, voting)  
 Office of Instructional Development (one, voting)  
 Director of Assessment and Regional Accreditation (one, voting)  
 Students (one undergraduate and one graduate, voting)

**Terms:** Faculty – three years  
 Immediate Past Chair (one year)  
 Vice-Provost – concurrent with office  
 Distance Education Librarian of Chester Fritz Library – concurrent with office  
 Office of Extended Learning – concurrent with office  
 Center for Instructional and Learning Technologies – concurrent with office  
 Office of Instructional Development – concurrent with office  
 Director of Assessment and Regional Accreditation – concurrent with office  
 Undergraduate student enrolled in an online or distance degree program (one year)  
 Graduate student enrolled in an online or distance degree program (one year)

**Selection:** Approximately one-third elected by the University Senate in April and assuming responsibilities Fall Semester.  
 Undergraduate student selected by Student Government in April and assuming responsibility Fall Semester; graduate student to be nominated by the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies and approved for membership by a majority vote of the Graduate Studies Committee.

**Functions and Responsibilities:** Acting of its own volition, upon the request of the Senate and/or others, the committee shall assume the following responsibilities:

1. Advocate for the use of "best practices" relative to faculty development, delivery methods, and the administration, teaching and evaluation of courses and programs offered for credit in the extended learning environment (i.e., those courses and programs offered online and as distance education offerings).
2. Foster collaboration to achieve the committee's purpose.

3. Provide support and assistance to deans, departmental chairs and program directors relative to the management, monitoring, and evaluation of online and distance education courses.
4. Provide oversight for quality and integrity in the extended learning environment, while being guided by the principle that academic standards reside within academic departments.
5. Make resource recommendations to the institution congruent with achieving our purpose statement.
6. Promote campus-wide interest in and advocacy for UND's role in providing exceptional and enriching extended learning experiences.

Report to Senate: Prepare an annual report and submit it to the Senate secretary two weeks before the March Senate meeting.

**Resolution in Support of a Motion to be presented to the University Senate  
at its May 5, 2016 Meeting**

Whereas the University is in a state of crisis and there is an immediate and continuing need for a faculty voice in this state of affairs, we support the following motion to be made to the University Senate at its meeting May 5, 2016:

“Move to create an ad hoc committee of the University Senate called the Faculty Assembly and composed of all tenured UND faculty without full-time administrative appointments. The committee, reporting to the University Senate, will meet at least monthly in 2016-2017 to discuss and take positions on matters relevant to the faculty. For purposes of conducting business, 10% of tenured faculty will constitute a quorum of the Assembly.

The Faculty Assembly will:

- Solicit input from all UND faculty on matters affecting the faculty and its responsibilities
- Discuss and take positions on these matters deemed appropriate for faculty action
- Convey these positions to the University Senate
- Recommend to the University Senate by its April 2017 meeting whether the Faculty Assembly should be continued, modified, or replaced with an alternative means for faculty voice.”
