Dear Mr. Grotte:

I have received a letter from the Superintendent, Fort Berthold Agency, Elbowoods, North Dakota, in response to my recent inquiry in your behalf. His letter reads in part as follows:

"We are also concerned with this fence cutting business. Apparently both Indians and white operators are occasionally involved in the cutting of fences. The only feasible manner of handling this situation is for those parties who have property damages by these acts to identify the wire cutters and file damage charges against them in court. This office will give any assistance possible in bringing them to justice."
