Your name appears first on a petition that I have received from citizens of Elbowoods seeking my full cooperation in the passage of H. R. 3219, to exclude North Dakota Indians from the provisions of the Wheeler-Howard Act, so I am writing to you to assure you that inasmuch as I introduced this bill, there is no doubt about my keen desire to see it passed in Congress.

The Congress is not doing anything now and will not until after election, but you may be certain that I will continue to do my very best in the interests of the Indians in North Dakota and other parts of the country.
