Dear Mr. Grotte:

This will acknowledge your recent letter telling me about the trouble you and your neighbors are having in trying to keep stray horses out of your fields.

If your fences are being deliberately cut, you should certainly ask the sheriff to make an investigation. I am taking the matter up with the Indian agency at Elbowoods to see if there is anything that they can do to keep these horses from damaging your fields.
