Dear Mr. Myer:

I am writing you in behalf of Mr. Fred Burr, ^{see}
873 Marshall, St. Paul, Minnesota, who is from the Ft. Berthold
Reservation of North Dakota, but who left some years ago and has
been independent since.

Mr. Burr has about 400 acres of land on the Reserva-
tion which he was forced to sell in connection with the construc-
tion of the Garrison Dam. Mr. Burr is anxious to receive his full
share of tribal funds in cash together with any interest and other
assets in the tribal fund and wants to sever relations.

Would you be so good as to advise me in this matter
at your early convenience.
