Dear Mr. Fox:

This will acknowledge your letter of the 21st. I am enclosing a letter I received from Mr. J. H. Newton, Clerk of the Supreme Court of North Dakota, which I received Saturday, in which he advises me that the Supreme Court has not decided the question.

Until the Supreme Court does decide the Attorney General has ordered the United States Attorney for North Dakota not to file any papers there. Governor Brunsdale has, however, kept his promise to have the legislature consider the entire problem at this session and Joe Wicks is keeping his promise to do what he can to see that it is properly presented to the Legislature.

As you know, I had four days of hearings from early in the morning until late at night in order to get the material that might be properly presented. Until we know what the Supreme Court of North Dakota does, we can't go any farther.

If you have any suggestions on this, I certainly should like to have them.
