Dear Mrs. Chapin:

This will acknowledge and thank you for your recent letter, expressing your interest in S. J. Res. 11, of which I am co-sponsor, providing for the ratification by Congress of a contract for the purchase of certain Indian lands by the United States from the Three Affiliated Tribes of Fort Berthold Reservation.

I was certainly glad to hear from you and I am today sending you under separate cover a copy of the Congressional Record of July 6, which outlines the Senate amendments to the companion measure, H. J. Res. 33. The pages, which I have marked, are 9101 to 9105.

You will be interested to know, also, that the House disagreed to the Senate amendments and, consequently, requested a Conference. The Conference appointed are Senators Kerr, McFarland, Miller, Ecton and Watkins.

I shall continue to do all I can to secure early enactment of this legislation and, if you have any suggestions as to how I can be of further assistance, please be sure to let me know.
