Dear Mr. Hamilton:

I have received your letter of October 27 and wish to say there is very little money in the Department to the credit of the Indians, about \$2500 for travel purposes and \$5500 more they can get, so the matter will have to be taken care of by an appropriation.

I have wired Mr. Cross to come down and when he gets here I will lay the matter squarely before him. It will be governed by what he wants done.
