Indian affair September 22, 1955 Hon. Glenn L. Emmons, Commissioner Bureau of Indian Affairs Department of the Interior C-John Hart Washington 25, D. C. Dear Mr. Commissioner: I am writing you relative to a series of three industrial development meetings near the Indian reservations in North Dakota. These meetings were held at Dunseith, North Dakota, the evening of September 14, at New Town, North Dakota, at noon Thursday, the 15th, and at Devils Lake, North Dakota, the evening of September 15th. My information is that an extreme amount of enthusiasm for the development of an electronic industry in these various communities was evidenced by the large attendance. Your Assistant, Carl Beck, told the assembled people of the active prospects in the electronics industry for the communities adjacent to Indian reservations.
